

Overall Description

The Indigenous Traditional Ecological & Cultural Knowledge Center is a single floor space mainly made up of office spaces. There are ADA entrances both on the south side and the northern eastern side of the building.

Restrooms

Restrooms are located towards the northwest corner of the building along corridor C102. Room 105 is the women's restroom located east and 104 is the men's restroom located west.

Wheelchair Accessible Entrances and Exits

Wheelchair entry into the building can only be made via Floor 1. Wheelchairs enter on SW Harrison St via the walk of Heroines.

Elevators

There is no elevator located inside the Indigenous Traditional Ecological & Cultural Knowledge Center.

Stairs

There is no stairwell located inside the Indigenous Traditional Ecological & Cultural Knowledge Center.
