

Culturally Responsive Leaders Program



The Culturally Responsive Leaders Project provides a specialized M.S.W. pathway for culturally competent and responsive child welfare leaders for public, tribal and private contracted child welfare agencies.

Program participants will receive \$11,000 per year and will participate in specialized field experiences, seminars and national networking opportunities in addition to the regular school curriculum. Students will sign an agreement agreeing to work one year in child welfare for every year of stipend support received. This can include working for Tribal Child Welfare Systems or private agencies providing contracted services for public child welfare.
