Re: Summary of Faculty Senate Actions

At the regular meeting on 6 June 2022 (held as an on-line conference), Faculty Senate **approved** the curricular **Consent Agenda** with the new courses, changes to courses, dropped courses, and changes to programs listed in Attachment E.1 to the June 6th Agenda.

Faculty Senate further **voted to approve**:

- the Graduate Certificate in Affordable Housing Development, a new program in the College of Urban and Public Affairs, as summarized in Attachment E.2.
- the Undergraduate Certificate in Indigenous Traditional Ecological and Cultural Knowledge, a new program in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, as summarized in Attachment E.3.
- the Undergraduate Certificate in Comparative Literary and Cultural Studies, a new program in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, as summarized in Attachment E.4.
- the initial list of courses to fulfill the undergraduate Race and Ethnic Studies Requirement given in Attachment E.5.
