### **Posted Summary**

Portland State University is launching two academic programs in Washington County in fall 2012. One program will provide upper division courses leading to a BS degree in electrical engineering. The second program will provide graduate courses leading to an MS degree in electrical and computer engineering. These programs are designed primarily for working professionals who wish to complete their degree requirements during the evenings and weekends. These programs will also be designed so that lecture content can be delivered offline through the web and time in the classroom and laboratories will employ active learning techniques that also encourage networking and the development of lasting professional relationships. The program director will lead this effort and engage prospective students, technology companies in Washington County, and partner academic institutions and community colleges.
