The position includes teaching and advising responsibilities in the undergraduate and master's degree programs in Political Science as well as the doctoral program in Public Affairs and Policy.

The Mark O. Hatfield School of Government is part of the College of Urban and Public Affairs, and faculty members are encouraged to participate in inter-disciplinary scholarship within the college.
