Please Note: IDS track courses should include substantial discussion of the topic in the context of developing nations. Other courses not listed may be counted for IDS with advisor approval, but you must make a good case for it to count and must get advisor approval prior to taking it. In addition, you must arrange with the instructor of the course to focus your projects in developing nations. For example, some courses in Public Health could be used for IDS track if the student is interested in practical questions of health in developing nations and the instructor of the Public Health course is willing to assist the student in redirecting the course projects to focus on issues of developing nations. Courses with a regional focus are generally not allowed, but exceptions can be made when the topic is particularly relevant to development.
