PSU responds to bomb threat with high vigilance

On the morning of October 25, 2007 a Portland State University campus service officer discovered a note containing a bomb threat during a routine patrol on campus. A second note was located soon afterward.

To safeguard human life and property, campus public safety officers and University support teams quickly conducted a thorough search of all campus buildings. No suspicious devices or packages were located. The campus incident response team consulted with the Portland Police Department and the FBI.

In consultation with the Portland Police Department, the decision was made to not evacuate campus buildings. The campus incident response team remains vigilant for unusual objects or other threats.
