The Chemistry Department at Portland State University plans to hire a full-time, tenure-track faculty member with research interests in Organic Chemistry, to begin Fall 2012. We expect to hire an Assistant Professor, but level and starting dates may be negotiable for exceptional candidates. Teaching responsibilities will include the undergraduate organic & general chemistry curriculum as well as in the graduate curriculum and applicants should be able to demonstrate training and interest commensurate with this role. The faculty member will be expected to establish a vigorous externally-funded research program in one of the aforementioned research areas. Women and under-represented minority candidates are especially encouraged to apply.

Portland State University is Oregon's urban university, pleasantly located along the Park Blocks in downtown Portland. The Chemistry Department supports an ACS-accredited undergraduate program in chemistry and disciplinary M.A., M.S., and Ph.D. degree programs in Chemistry as well as an interdisciplinary Ph.D. program in Environmental Sciences and Resources/Chemistry. Research in the chemistry department is focused on environmental chemistry, biological chemistry, and materials chemistry.

The starting annual salary rate for this position will be dependent upon qualifications and experience with an excellent benefits package including fully paid healthcare; a generous retirement; and reduced tuition rates for employee, spouse or dependent at any of the Oregon University System schools.

Applicants should provide a current C.V.
