Ph.D. in Psychology (or closely related field)
Previous experience teaching large undergraduate classes in psychology

Courses are paid on a per credit basis, starting at the current rate of \$2984 for a 4-credit course, depending on qualifications.

To apply:

Applicants should provide a letter of interest specifying desired courses and availability (for summer, fall, winter, and/or spring quarter), curriculum vita, evidence of teaching experience (including summaries of teaching evaluations if possible), and names and contact information for two professional references with knowledge of the candidate's teaching qualifications. The inclusion of letters from these references would be a strong asset to the application.
