Students wishing to transfer in at higher levels (290, 390, 490) should consult the area coordinator before preparing for their audition.

Undergraduate Flute Audition Requirements

Mozart G or D major concerto, First Movement, no cadenza

A contrasting piece from standard solo literature, for example the Concertino by Chaminade or a movement of a Bach Sonata.

One Etude

Full Range Chromatic Scale

Graduate Flute Audition Requirements

Mozart Concerto in G or D major, First Movement, no cadenza

Sonata by Bach

Piece from the standard French repertoire, for example works by Dutilleux, Gaubert or Taffanel.

Three orchestral excerpts of your choice.
