

## 2011-12 Graduate Assistant Tuition Remission

All Graduate Assistants must register for and successfully complete a minimum of 9 graduate credits applicable to their degree program each term of the assistantship except summer. The 2011-12 graduate assistant remission amount is based on the FTE of the graduate assistantship and will pay a portion of instructional costs (tuition). Because of the differentiated tuition structure for different programs, remissions will not necessarily correspond to the instructional costs of a specific credit hour load. Although the Technology Fee, Resource Fee, and Student Services Fee have been incorporated into the tuition structure, the student will be responsible for Building, Incidental, Academic Student Recreation Center (ASRC), and Health Service Fees (\$536 per full time student), regardless of the remission amount indicated by the FTE.

<u>FTE RANGE</u>	<u>Minimum Tuition Remission Amount</u>
.15-.24	\$2,500
.25-.34	\$3,000
.35-.44	\$3,750
.45-.49	\$4,500

In no case, however, can the tuition remission amount be MORE than the tuition cost. (see attached chart).

NOTE: These figures are the minimum remission amounts for the FTE ranges. If a grant or department is willing AND has the funds, the grant or department has the option of paying additional amount, NOT to exceed the tuition cost (student is responsible for the Student Fees). Instructional costs for PE credits cannot be covered with tuition remission.
