Rough draft of History Department Undergraduate Learning Outcomes (for purposes of undergraduate program assessment):

1. Primary source research: Students will learn to identify and analyze primary sources, and to explain how the documents support or undermine different historical interpretations.
2. Secondary source research: Students will learn to identify, analyze, compare and critique works of historical scholarship.
3. Communication: Students will learn to communicate the results of their research effectively through speaking, writing and other audio-visual media.
4. Knowledge: Students will develop a broad knowledge of relevant historical information, as relevance is understood in the current historical scholarship.
5. Professional skills: Students will develop skills that are applicable in three professional categories: teaching history, public history, and all other careers that, though not considered professional history, are nonetheless enhanced by the knowledge and methodologies learned through History courses.
