**Notes for students planning to sit for the CPA exam:**

- ACTG 485 and ACTG 407 Accounting Data Analytics count toward the accounting elective requirements for the post-bac certificate and undergraduate degree requirements, and are strongly encouraged for students who plan to take the CPA. However, if you plan to take the CPA exam in Oregon, undergraduate degree seeking students should take a second elective to ensure sufficient “accounting-related” credits for purposes of CPA exam eligibility. The Oregon Board of Accountancy classifies ACTG 485 as “business-related.” ACTG 407 Accounting Data Analytics is a new course for which no determination has yet been made.
- To prepare thoroughly for the CPA exam, we recommend that you take all of the following electives: ACTG 422, 485 & 493.
