

**PSU University Honors College
Admission & Scholarship Information for Grant and Riverdale High School
Honors Global City Seminar Students for 2019-20**

Grant and Riverdale High School seniors enrolled in the University Honors College first-year seminar, the Global City, who successfully complete it, earning 15 credits, and who meet all other Honors College minimum requirements for admission (3.50 cumulative unweighted high school GPA **or** 1250 SAT **or** 27 ACT score), are invited to submit a Challenge priority application to the University Honors College.

With a later submission date (March 1st) Challenge students will be able to upload their Honors Global City seminar portfolio in lieu of the standard Honors College Admissions essays.

Acceptance into the University Honors College is contingent on meeting eligibility requirements and assessment of the portfolio.

Those Grant and Riverdale Global City students accepted into the Honors College will receive a \$1500 scholarship (\$500/term during the academic year) annually for a total of four years, contingent on maintaining the required 3.25 GPA.

Please note that students will need to submit the regular PSU application as well as completing and submitting the Honors College application.
