

# **BA** or **BS** + **MS** in Communication

Students in the BA or BS in Communication program may be admitted directly into the MS in Communication program and share up to 20 credits of graduate level credit with the BA/BS and MS in Communication.

#### **Admissions Criteria**

Communication majors may apply for admission to the Bachelors plus Masters program provided the following conditions have been met:

- Completed all core Communication undergraduate courses: Comm 300, Comm 311, and Comm 316 or Comm 326 with an average GPA of 3.7 or higher
- On track to complete at least 135 undergraduate credits towards the Bachelors degree before the fall term in which the student wishes to begin the Bachelors plus MS program.
- A GPA of 3.5 or above is required for all communication classes taken prior to entry into the MS program, along with a PSU institutional GPA of 3.3.

### **Other Requirements**

- All courses numbered 500 and above taken prior to entry into the master's program must receive a grade of B or better. All undergraduate classes must receive a grade of C or better. No P/NP credit will be accepted for either program.
- The departmental residency requirement for undergraduate credits prior to admission is 16 credits. The PSU institutional requirement for residency for the undergraduate program is that 45 of the last 60 credits must be taken in residence at PSU. All MS level classes must be taken at PSU, and earn a grade of B or better.

Students can apply for the Bachelors plus Masters in spring of their junior year to be eligible to take 500-level courses in their senior year. The Bachelors plus Masters program must begin in fall of their final year as an undergraduate with enrollment in Comm 521.

#### Advising

Initially, students will be advised by their undergraduate adviser, in consultation with the graduate program director, who will assist them in preparing their application for the Bachelors plus Masters. Once students have begun the master's sequence, they will be advised by the faculty mentor assigned to them and the graduate program director.

#### **Continuation Criteria**

After beginning the Bachelors plus Masters program, continuation requirements include:

- maintaining a 3.3 PSU institutional GPA (university requirement)
- a B or higher on all graduate courses taken for shared credits (university requirement)
- a minimum 3.0 GPA each academic term
- satisfactorily complete each undergraduate course attempted (C or better)
- incompletes must be resolved within one academic term
- secure a graduate advisor before completing undergraduate requirements
