





BANQUET DINING



The Walter C. Bowen Grand Hall is the centerpiece of Viking Pavilion's wraparound concourse. It's a perfect spot for secure entry, information tabling, beverage service, concessions and vendor booths. Add plenty of "extras" to take your event to the next level (or at least from the Arena to the concourse). The Grand Hall can be reserved for small banquets and intimate speaking engagements.

MULTIPURPOSE SPACES


Portland State uses them as classrooms. You can plan to use them as breakout spaces, preparation space or private meeting rooms. With up-to-date multimedia gear and a variety of set-up configurations, these modern spaces offer event versatility.

Use of classrooms is subject to PSU academic scheduling needs.

- One seminar room (capacity of 72)
- Four classrooms (capacity of 35 per)
- One Green Room (capacity of 30)


ARENA SUITES

Suite guests can have an up-close view of the action while enjoying service from a catering special menu. Seating can be varied — focused on the floor or on the business being done right there in the suite.






EVENT SUPPORT

Don't let the campus setting fool you. Viking Pavilion is operated by a professional events staff who are available from initial contact to the final scrap of paperwork. During your event, staff is supervised by a cadre of trained student workers. The daily rate includes one event manager per 500 attendees. Managers are experienced in everything from set-up assistance to guest support.

The Campus Events office is located on the west end of the Arena.

The Guest Relations office is easy for attendees to find on the Grand Concourse.



The Viking Pavilion loading area is located on the north side of the building facing Millar Library. It allows direct access to the Arena floor. Carts are provided to transfer items.

The approach ramp can accommodate trucks up to 26 feet (8.5 feet width, 22,000 gross tons). Access to the ramp has to be pre-approved and stanchions removed prior to use.

Loading dock door is 17 feet wide by 14 feet high. (17' x 14')

Loading zone permits available through the Campus Events office.





Feeder Cable Examples

- 75 feet of feeder cable is sufficient for most north/south end stages
- 150 feet of feeder cable is needed for stages at center court configurations
- Special set-ups may cause these estimates to vary.

Temporary Power Boxes: Temporary Power Boxes and/ or adapters have to be approved by Viking Pavilion's consulting electrician and meet testing standards of Nationally Recognized Testing Laboratories (NRTL). Viking Pavilion will monitor compliance of all vendors and use of convenience outlets (110V) which are to be used exclusively for consumer-rated items such as laptop computers, cell phones, tablets or similar devices.

TABLES, CHAIRS

We provide set-up and tear-down of tables and seating. Our inventory includes:

- 7-foot round tables (seats 10)
- 6'x3' rectangle tables
- 6'x1.5' seminar tables
- Bistro tall tables
- Chairs



STAGING

Viking Pavilion has an inventory of staging that can build up to a 24 feet by 44 feet platform. The modular SICO design allows for a number of configurations with a load limit of 250 pounds per square foot.

The stage surface is black fiberglass/ grey carpet.

Concert stages can be built in 2-inch increments from 4' to 6'5" in height on rolling frames. Ramp sections make them easily accessible.

There are multiple step units to accommodate all the stage heights above. Stage skirting is black and fits stage heights up to 6'5".



BACKDROPS, DRAPING

We have options to accentuate or mask the Arena's sports motif.

Our west end truss (top) allows for a complete black background in the Arena, one that can be easily removed and won't interfere with lighting systems. The west running curtain (bottom) can create a smaller barrier that leaves the floor open to the west wall.

Pipe and drape, stanchion poles and barrier gates are available for privacy, masking and stage effect.






FLOOR

The Arena floor is an NCAA Division I maple basketball court, so we take care of it. Non-athletic events make mandatory use of our charcoal protective carpet.

The substructure supports a wide variety of stages, platforms and seating. We've hosted wrestling rings, massive concert stages, vendor villages, crowds of spectators, even weighty circus infrastructure. No exotic animals, however, due to county ban.

The Arena floor, no seating sections set, is 120 feet x 248 feet (12,500 sq. ft). With bleachers extended, 85 feet by 200 feet (8,500 sq. ft.).

Concourse floors are polished concrete offering great flexibility.



MISC. TECH NOTES

Air movement and filtration —Viking Pavilion's open layout offers safe air movement. The building is equipped with MERV-13 Filters that have shown to be successful in filtering out the COVID-19 virus

Digital display boards — Two 20'x12' Daktronic digital display boards are located at the east and west ends of the Arena, easily visible from the bleachers and concourse level.

Use of the Daktronics requires support of the University's A/V department (CAVET). The boards can support live playback and pre-recorded material (AVI and H.264 files preferred).

Other screen and projection options available through CAVET.

Light rigging — The Arena can accommodate a number of lighting options. Rigging plans must be submitted at least 30 days in advance and approved by the CESU director's representative. A provision of the facility-use agreement is that all safety protocols must be followed



and installation overseen by Viking Pavilion's consultant, an expert on the Arena's features and limitations.

Follow spots — The building is equipped with 2k Lycian 1290XLT follow spots and has 12 follow spot perches.

Sound System (built-in) — Six main clusters surround the east and west digital scoreboard. Each cluster composed of 8 JBL cabinets (6-VLA601, 2-VLA901).

WiFi — PSU Guest wifi is available throughout the Concourse.

BOOKING POINTERS

- Your best first step is to speak with an expert Campus Events & Student Union representative at 503-725-2663 or conferences.pdx.edu. We can save you time with quick answers on availablity and procedures.
- All Portland State bookings must be made at least 30 days in advance of the event.
- Some events require permits from local governments that can take up to 60 days for approval. Please plan accordingly.
- Viking Pavilion events generally are scheduled up to six months to one year out. Ask our office about more advance planning.

TO SUPPORT THE MISSION OF PORTLAND STATE, OUR STUDENT AND FACULTY USE OF FACILITIES SUCH AS VIKING PAVILION TAKES PRECEDENT. SOME DATES ARE NOT AVAILABLE DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR DUE TO ATHLETIC EVENTS OR PSU STUDENT/DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES.

- Viking Pavilion can be reserved on an hourly or daily rate.
- All events are required to abide by the Campus Event & Student Union office's Facility Use Agreement. Some, but not all, items that are included in the agreement:
 - Rental charges, fees and deposits
 - Certificate of insurance requirement

- Permit requirements
- Prior floor/ceiling plan for event


COMMUTE/PARKING

The Portland State campus in southwest Portland is pedestrian-friendly and connected to public transit with three light rail lines, two streetcar lines, and 20-plus bus lines steps from our venues.




