## Law Enforcement AAS Degree Transfer Guide

All students must satisfy both Bachelor of Science degree requirements and Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) major requirements. Chemeketa students who complete an AAS degree in Law Enforcement can generally expect their courses to transfer to the PSU Bachelor of Science and CCJ major as shown below.

### I. AAS in Law Enforcement Degree Application to PSU Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 12 credits in Social Science or Arts & Letters general education requirement
    - Met by a combination of AAS in Law Enforcement required & elective courses
  - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU University Studies 15 credits Freshman Inquiry
    - Met by total AAS Law Enforcement degree credits earned
  - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 4 of 8 credit Writing Composition requirement
    - Met by completing WR121.
    - 4 credits of Writing Composition requirement remaining
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- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Transfer Credits:** PSU University Studies 12 credits Sophomore Inquiry can be satisfied with transfer of 90 credits to PSU
    - Not all AAS in Law Enforcement credits earned at Chemeketa CC transfer to PSU because vocational, cooperation education, and physical education credits are capped at 12 transfer credits each. Transfer credits are determined by PSU Admissions.

### II. AAS in Law Enforcement Degree Application to PSU Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) Major Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 3 CCJ required courses: 200/300, CCJ 230/301, and CCJ 240/303
  - Met by AAS in Law Enforcement required courses CJ101, CJ112 and **choosing** AAS in Law Enforcement Criminal Justice electives (1) CJ130 or CJ253.
  - 32 credits of required CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU
- ✓ **Satisfied:** 8 credits of CCJ elective courses
  - Met by a combination of required CJ courses for AAS in Law Enforcement
  - 16 credits of Upper Division elective CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU

#### ADDITIONAL COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PSU BACHELOR DEGREE IN CCJ TRANSFERS

*\*Courses in this section are not required in the Law Enforcement AAS degree plan. They are recommended for students seeking to satisfy additional Bachelor of Science degree requirements prior to transferring to PSU.*

✚ **PSU Science Requirement: 12 credits in any of the following sciences** - Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science/Studies, Geology, Physics, Sciences Education (SCI).

\_\_\_ 8 of the 12 Science credits must have a lab or fieldwork attached

\_\_\_ 4 of the 12 Science credits may be with or without a lab or fieldwork attached

✚ **PSU College Level Math Requirement: 4 credits in Math or Statistics at Level 105 or higher**

✚ **PSU Writing Composition Requirement: 4 credits of Writing Composition**
