PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires a minimum of 10 credits of Science coursework; of which 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must contain a lab or field work component. Completing the AAOT Science/Math/Computer Science requirement will fulfill the PSU Science requirement upon transfer.
AAOT Arts & Letters Requirement (3 courses) Must complete three courses from at least 2 disciplines within the Arts & Letters distribution. Arts & Letters courseArts & Letters courseArts & Letters course
PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires a minimum of 10 credits of Arts & Letters and/or Social Science coursework credits.
AAOT Social Science Requirement (4 courses) Must complete four courses from at least 2 disciplines within the Social Science distribution. Social Science course
AAOT Cultural Literacy Requirement (1 course) Complete one course from any discipline studies designated as meeting the statewide criteria for Cultural Literacy offered at your community college. Cultural Literacy course
AAOT Electives Requirement (90 credits): Must complete electives until student has earned a total of 90 credits.
PSU Transfer Tip: For students intending to major in Criminology and Criminal Justice (CCJ) at PSU, you can satisfy up to 3 required PSU CCJ courses at your community college and up to 8 CCJ additional elective credits.

All students must satisfy both Bachelor of Science degree requirements and Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) major requirements to complete their degree at Portland State University. Oregon Community College students who complete an AAOT degree can generally expect their courses to transfer to the PSU Bachelor of Science and CCJ major as shown below.

 - Met by AAOT degree Science/Math/Computer Science requirement

II. AAOT in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) Major Requirements
