##### **Social Science Specific Classes (16 credits)**

\_\_\_ Choose 12 credits from 100 level or higher ANTH, HST, PS, PSY, or SOC courses with the exception of 180/280 courses as substitutions. SWOCC recommends: SOC204, SOC205, and SOC206.

##### **Required General Elective Classes (9 credits)**

\_\_\_ Choose 9 credits of any course 100 level or higher not required for the degree.


 **PSU Transfer Tip:** Use SOCC General elective requirement to work towards meeting PSU writing requirement or PSU Science requirement.

##### **Required Speech Classes (3 credits)**

\_\_\_ Choose 3 credits of one of the following courses: SP100, SP111, SP218, or SP219 will satisfy this requirement.

##### **Required Math Classes (4 credits)**

\_\_\_ MTH60, MTH65, MTH95, MTH98 or higher.

 **PSU Transfer Tip:** Use SOCC Math requirement to work towards meeting PSU Math requirement of 3 credits in Math or Statistics level 105 or higher

##### **Required Health, Wellness and Fitness (3 credits)**

\_\_\_ Choose 3 credits of HE250, PE231 or PE185 sport/activity course to satisfy this requirement.

# Portland State University Bachelor of Science in Criminology & Criminal Justice

## Police Science AAS Degree Transfer Map

All students must satisfy both Bachelor of Science degree requirements and Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) major requirements. Southwestern Oregon CC students who complete an AAS degree in Police Science can generally expect their courses to transfer to the PSU Bachelor of Science and CCJ major as shown below.

### I. AAS in Police Science Degree Application to PSU Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 10 credits minimum in Social Science or Arts & Letters general education requirement
  - Met by a combination of AAS in Police Science required courses
- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU University Studies 15 credits Freshman Inquiry
  - Met by total AAS Police Science degree credits earned


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- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Transfer Credits:** PSU University Studies 12 credits Sophomore Inquiry can be satisfied with transfer of 90 credits to PSU
    - Not all AAS in Police Science credits earned at Southwestern Oregon CC transfer to PSU because vocational, cooperation education, and physical education credits are capped at 12 transfer credits each. Transfer credits are determined by PSU Admissions.

### II. AAS in Police Science Degree Application to PSU Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) Major Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** 8 credits of CCJ elective courses
  - Met by a combination of required CJ courses for AAS in Police Science
  - 16 credits of Upper Division elective CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU
- ✓ **May Be Satisfied Depending on Transfer Credits:** PSU 3 CCJ required courses: CCJ 200/300, CCJ 230/301, and CCJ 240/303
  - Met by AAS in Police Science required CJ courses CJ100, CJ110 and by choosing CJ130 towards specific electives needed for degree requirements.
  - 32 credits of required CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU

#### ADDITIONAL COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PSU BACHELOR DEGREE IN CCJ TRANSFERS

*\*Courses in this section are not required in the Police Science AAS degree plan. They are recommended for students seeking to satisfy additional Bachelor of Science degree requirements prior to transferring to PSU.*

 **PSU Science Requirement: 10 credits minimum in any of the following sciences** - Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science/Studies, Geology, Physics, or Sciences Education (SCI)

\_\_\_ Two courses must have lab or fieldwork component (6 credits minimum)

\_\_\_ Remaining credits to reach 10 credits minimum may be a non-lab or lab science

 **PSU College Level Math Requirement: 3 credits minimum in Math or Statistics at Level 105 or higher**

 **PSU Writing Composition Requirement: 4 credits of Writing Composition**
