#### Criminal Justice AAS Degree Requirement

##### **COCC Criminal Justice Required (25 credits)**


- CJ 100 Survey of the Criminal Justice System
- CJ 101 Introduction to Criminology
- CJ 120 Judicial Process
- CJ 153 Ethical Issues in Criminal Justice
- CJ 201 Introduction to Juvenile Justice
- CJ 243 Drugs and Crime in Society
- CJ 253 Corrections
- CJ 280 Co-op Work Experience Criminal Justice

##### **COCC Criminal Justice Electives (15-18 credits)**

- Choose 15-18 credits of CJ Coursework from CJ course options at COCC.


##### **COCC Education/Foundational Requirements (14 credits)**


- Health and Human Performance
- MTH 020 Pre-Algebra (or higher)
- SP 218 Interpersonal Communication
- WR 121 Academic Composition

 PSU Transfer Tip: COCC's WR 121 Academic Composition is equivalent to PSU's WR 121 College Writing. PSU requires 8 credits of college-level Writing Composition coursework. By completing WR 121 at COCC, a student will satisfy 4 of the 8 credits needed for the PSU University Writing Requirement.

##### **COCC Other Required Classes (23 credits)**


- SOC 201 Introduction to Sociology
- PSY 233 Psych of Violence & Aggression
- ED 265 Children at Risk
- Choose 8 credits of Psychology courses other than PSY 233.
- Choose 4 credits of Social Science Distribution courses without a CJ prefix.


 PSU Transfer Tip: PSU's BS requires a minimum of 10 credits of Arts & Letters or Social Science coursework. By completing the Psychology requirement at COCC, a student will satisfy 8 credits of the 10 credits minimum Arts & Letters or Social Science requirement.


 PSU Transfer Tip: If a student has already met the BS 10 credits Arts & Letters or Social Science requirement; any additional credits will transfer into the general education elective bucket at PSU. Therefore, credits will still transfer in towards overall credits earned and overall GPA at PSU.

##### **COCC General Elective Requirements (13-16 credits)**

- Choose enough credits to reach degree minimum 93 credits in any class at COCC from the Discipline Studies list.

 PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires a minimum of 3 credits of Math level 105 or higher. Prioritize using AAS remaining 13-16 CR of Gen. Electives to satisfy PSU's math requirement first. Number of COCC math prerequisites needed to register for Math 105 depends on COCC math placement results.

 PSU Transfer Tip: After PSU's math requirement is satisfied, use remaining Gen. Electives to work towards completing PSU's 10 credits minimum Science requirement.

 PSU Transfer Tip: If any remaining Gen. Elective utilize WR 122 or WR 227 to complete PSU writing requirement.

## Portland State University Bachelor of Science in Criminology & Criminal Justice

### Criminal Justice AAS Degree Transfer Guide

All students must satisfy both Bachelor of Science degree requirements and Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) major requirements. Central Oregon Community College students who complete an AAS degree in Criminal Justice can generally expect their courses to transfer to the PSU Bachelor of Science and CCJ major as shown below.

#### I. AAS in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 12 credits minimum in Social Science or Arts & Letters general education requirement
    - Met by a combination of AAS in Criminal Justice required & elective courses
  - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU University Studies 15 credits Freshman Inquiry
    - Met by total AAS Criminal Justice degree credits earned
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- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 3 credits minimum Math requirement
    - May be satisfied **if** student utilizes 13-16 credits of required Gen. elective coursework to complete Math 105 or higher.
    - Number of COCC prerequisites required to register for Math 105 varies depending on a student's COCC math placement test results.
  - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 10 credits minimum Science requirement; of which 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component
  - May be satisfied **if** student has already reached Math 105 or higher, and is able to utilize 13-16 credits of required Gen. elective coursework to complete 10 credits minimum Science requirement; of which 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component.
  - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 8 credit Writing Composition requirement
    - 4 of the 8 credits are satisfied by WR 121 Academic Composition at COCC.
    - The remaining 4 credits of writing composition may be satisfied **if** student utilizes 13-16 credits of required Gen. elective coursework to complete 8 credit PSU Writing Composition requirement.
  - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Transfer Credits:** PSU University Studies 12 credits Sophomore Inquiry can be satisfied with transfer of 90 credits to PSU
    - Not all AAS in Criminal Justice credits earned at Central Oregon CC transfer to PSU because vocational, cooperation education, and physical education credits are capped at 12 transfer credits each. Transfer credits are determined by PSU Admissions.

#### II. AAS in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) Major Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 3 CCJ required courses: CCJ 200/300, CCJ 230/301, and CCJ 240/303
  - Met by AAS in Criminal Justice required courses CJ 100, CJ 110, and CJ 253
  - 32 credits of required CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU
- ✓ **Satisfied:** 8 credits of CCJ elective courses
  - Met by a combination of required and elective CJ courses for AAS in Criminal Justice
  - 16 credits of Upper Division elective CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU

#### ADDITIONAL COURSE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PSU BACHELOR DEGREE IN CCJ TRANSFERS

*\*Courses in this section are not specifically required in the Criminal Justice AAS degree plan. They are recommended for students seeking to satisfy additional Bachelor of Science degree requirements prior to transferring to PSU.*



**PSU Writing Requirement: 4 additional credits in college writing composition**

WR 121 will satisfy only 4 of 8 credits needed for PSU Writing Requirement.



**PSU Science Requirement: 10 credits minimum in any of the following sciences** - Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science/Studies, Geology, Physics, Sciences Education (SCI).

\_\_\_ Two courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component

\_\_\_ Remaining credits to reach 10 CR minimum may be with or without a lab or fieldwork attached
