MHCC AGS Math Requirement (1 course)

___ **MTH 058*** or MTH 065 or above

 PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 3 credits minimum of college level Math or Statistics. Completing the minimum math course to meet the AGS Math requirement at MHCC will **not** allow a student to meet the Math requirements for the Bachelor of Science at PSU. We encourage students to work towards completing MTH 105 or higher while at MHCC. **To be on correct Math Pathway at MHCC to work towards completing MTH 105 or MTH 111, PSU recommends completing MTH 058.*

MHCC AGS Written Communication Requirement (1 course)


Must choose one MHCC course from options below:

___ **WR 121** English Composition (4 cr)

___ **WR 122** English Composition: Critical Thinking (4 cr)

___ **WR 227** Technical Report Writing (4 cr)

___ WR 101 Workplace Communications (3 cr)

 PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 8 credits of college-level Writing Composition coursework. If student **chooses** WR 121, WR 122, or WR 227 this will meet 4 of the 8 credits needed for the PSU University Writing requirement.

MHCC AGS Oral Communication Requirement (1 course)

 PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 10 credits minimum of Arts & Letters and/or Social Science coursework credits. Any MHCC COMM class from options listed will transfer in as Arts & Letters coursework at PSU. PSU recommends taking a **4 credit COMM** course to fulfill this requirement at MHCC.

MHCC AGS Health & Physical Education (3 credits)

___ Must complete 3 credits in Health & Physical Education.

 PSU Transfer Tip: 3 credits of any Health & Physical Education coursework from MHCC will transfer into PSU's general education elective bucket. PSU allows students to transfer in a maximum of 12 credits of Health & Physical Education coursework.

MHCC AGS Science/Math/Computer Science Requirement (2 courses)

Must complete two courses within the Science/Math/Computer Science distribution at MHCC.

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 10 credits minimum of Science coursework; of which, 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component. To work towards satisfying the PSU Science requirement upon transfer from the AGS Degree at MHCC, **PSU recommends taking 2 courses (6 credits minimum) of Lab Science** as follows:

MHCC AGS Arts & Letters Requirement (2 courses)

Must complete two courses within the Arts & Letters distribution at MHCC. MHCC recommends PHL 202.

___ Arts & Letters course at MHCC

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 10 credits minimum of Arts & Letters and/or Social Science coursework credits. Choose any 2 courses from MHCC Arts & Letters coursework options, except the following:

-HUM 202, RD 117, R 210, R 211, R 212

MHCC AGS Social Science Requirement (2 courses)

Must complete two courses within the Social Science distribution at MHCC.

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: Choose any 6 credits from MHCC Social Science coursework options, except the following:

-World Literature Studies coursework options at MHCC

MHCC AGS Recommended Electives

Must complete MHCC electives until student has earned a total of 90-degree credits.

✚ PSU Transfer Tip #1: **Choosing** CJA 111, CJA 112, & CJA 113 will transfer in for 3 PSU CCJ major required courses. In addition, by choosing any of the other MHCC CJA recommended electives up to 8 credits of CJA coursework will transfer in for 8 credits of CCJ Major Elective courses at PSU.

✚ PSU Transfer Tip #2: For students **who have not yet reached the following PSU Bachelor's degree requirements**, we recommend students utilize their remaining MHCC recommended electives to complete the following PSU requirements:

- PSU requires 3 credits minimum of college-level math (MTH 105 or higher).

- PSU requires 10 credits minimum of science coursework; of which, 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component.

- PSU requires 8 credits of college writing composition coursework.

Associate of General Studies (AGS) in Criminal Justice Degree Transfer Guide

All students must satisfy both Bachelor of Science degree requirements and Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) major requirements. Mt. Hood Community College students who complete an AGS degree in Criminal Justice can generally expect their courses to transfer to the PSU Bachelor of Science and CCJ major as shown below.

I. AGS in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 10 credits minimum in Social Science or Arts & Letters general education requirement
 - Met by a combination of AGS in Criminal Justice required courses
 - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU University Studies 15 credits Freshman Inquiry
 - Met by total AGS in Criminal Justice degree credits earned
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- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 3 credits minimum Math requirement
 - May be satisfied **if** student places directly into MTH 105 or higher to complete AGS Math Requirement.
 - May be satisfied **if** student who does not place directly into MTH 105 or higher utilizes MHCC recommended elective bucket to work towards completing MTH 105 or higher.
 - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 8 credit Writing requirement
 - May be satisfied **if** student utilizes MHCC recommended electives bucket to complete additional 4 credits of writing composition course.
 - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 10 credits minimum Science requirement; of which 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component
 - May be satisfied **if** student utilizes required MHCC Science/Math/Computer Science coursework to complete 2 lab science courses.
 - **If needed**, utilizes MHCC recommended elective bucket to complete additional credits of science coursework (lab or non-lab) to reach a minimum of 10 overall science credits.
 - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Transfer Credits:** PSU University Studies 12 credits Sophomore Inquiry can be satisfied with transfer of 90 credits to PSU
 - Not all AGS in Criminal Justice credits earned at Mt. Hood CC transfer to PSU because vocational, cooperative education, and physical education credits are capped at 12 transfer credits each. Transfer credits are determined by PSU Admissions.

II. AGS in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) Major Requirements

- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 3 CCJ required courses: CCJ 200/300, CCJ 230/301, and CCJ 240/303
 - May be satisfied **if** student chooses the following MHCC CJA courses to fill their recommended electives bucket:
 - CJA 111, CJA 112, and CJA 113.
- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** 8 credits of CCJ elective courses
 - May be satisfied **if** student takes an additional 8 credits of CJA MHCC courses to fill their recommended electives bucket.

Math or Statistics course at level 105 or higher (3 cr)	May be satisfied if student places directly into MTH 105 or higher to complete MHCC AGS Math requirement. Or for students who do not place into MTH 105 or higher, utilizes MHCC recommended elective bucket to work towards completing MTH 105 or higher.
PSU Bachelor of Science: Science Requirement (10 credits minimum) in Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics, Environmental Science/Studies, or Sciences Education (SCI)	
Two science courses must include a lab or field work component (6 credits minimum)	May be satisfied if student chooses 2 courses of lab science coursework to fulfill the MHCC Science/Math/ Computer Science requirement
One year of science courses (10 credits minimum)	May be satisfied if student chooses non-lab or lab science coursework to fulfill the MHCC Science/Math/ Computer Science requirement
PSU Bachelor Degree: University Studies Lower Division (27 credits)	
Freshman Inquiry (15 cr): Satisfied with transfer of 45 credits to PSU	✓Credits earned
Sophomore Inquiry (12 cr): Satisfied with transfer of 90 credits to PSU. All AS credits earned may not transfer. *	Depends on credit composition
