ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE (AS) IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

MHCC AS Math Requirement- (1 course)

___ MTH 105 or above

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 3 credits minimum of Math/Statistics (Math must be level 105 or higher). By completing the Math requirement at MHCC, a student will satisfy the BS 3 credits minimum Math/Statistics requirement at PSU.

MHCC AS Written Communication Requirement- (2 courses)

___ WR 121 English Composition

___ WR 227 Technical Report Writing or WR 122 English Composition: Critical Thinking

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 8 credits of college-level Writing Composition coursework. By completing the Written Communication requirement at MHCC, a student will satisfy all 8 credits of the PSU University Writing Requirement.

MHCC AS Oral Communication Requirement- (1 course)

Must choose one MHCC course from options below:

___ COMM 111 Fundamentals of Public Speaking (4 cr)

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 10 credits minimum of Arts & Letters/or Social Science coursework credits. Any MHCC COMM class from options listed will transfer in as Arts & Letters coursework at PSU.

MHCC AS Health & Physical Education- (3 credits)

___ Must complete 3 credits in Health & Physical Education

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: 3 credits of any Health & Physical Education coursework from MHCC will transfer into PSU's general education elective bucket. PSU allows students to transfer in a maximum of 12 credits of Health & Physical Education coursework.

MHCC students must complete a minimum of 9 credits in one of the categories below and a minimum of 6 credits in the other two categories.

1.) MHCC AS Science/Math/Computer Science Requirement- (can be lab or non-lab)

___ Must complete 6-9 credits in Science/Math/Computer Science coursework

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 10 credits minimum of Science coursework; of which, 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component. To satisfy the PSU science requirement upon transfer from the AS Degree at MHCC, **PSU recommends taking 10 credits of Science courses as follows:**

___ One Lab Science course

___ One Lab Science course

___ **If needed**, one lab or non-lab science course

2.) MHCC AS Arts & Letters Requirement

___ Must complete 6-9 credits in Arts & Letters coursework

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: Choose any 6 credits from MHCC Arts & Letters coursework options **except** the following:

-HUM 202, RD 117, R 210, R 211, R 212

MHCC AS Social Science Requirement

___ Must complete 6-9 credits Social Science coursework

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: Choose any 6 credits from MHCC Social Science coursework options **except** the following:

-World Literature Studies coursework options at MHCC

MHCC AS Recommended Electives

Must complete MHCC electives until student has earned a total of 90-degree credits.

✚ PSU Transfer Tip: Choosing **CJA 111, CJA 112, and CJA 113** will transfer in for 3 PSU CCJ major required courses. In addition, by choosing any of the other MHCC CJA recommended electives **up to 8 credits of CJA coursework** will transfer in for 8 credits of CCJ Major Elective courses at PSU.

Associate of Science (AS) in Criminal Justice Degree Transfer Guide

All students must satisfy both Bachelor of Science degree requirements and Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) major requirements. Mt. Hood Community College students who complete an AS degree in Criminal Justice can generally expect their courses to transfer to the PSU Bachelor of Science and CCJ major as shown below.

I. AS in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 8 credit Writing requirement
 - WR121 & WR 122 or WR 227
 - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 10 credits minimum in Social Science or Arts & Letters general education requirement
 - Met by a combination of AS in Criminal Justice required courses
 - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 3 credits minimum Math requirement
 - Met by required AS in Criminal Justice Math Requirement
 - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU University Studies 15 credits Freshman Inquiry
 - Met by total AS in Criminal Justice degree credits earned

- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 10 credits minimum Science requirement; of which 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must have a lab or field work component
 - May be satisfied if student utilizes 10 credits of required MHCC Science/Math/Computer Science coursework to complete 10 credits minimum of Science coursework at PSU; of which, 2 courses (6 credits minimum) must be Lab Science coursework.
 - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Transfer Credits:** PSU University Studies 12 credits Sophomore Inquiry can be satisfied with transfer of 90 credits to PSU
 - Not all AS in Criminal Justice credits earned at Mt. Hood CC transfer to PSU because vocational, cooperative education, and physical education credits are capped at 12 transfer credits each. Transfer credits are determined by PSU Admissions.

II. AS in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) Major Requirements

- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 3 CCJ required courses: CCJ 200/300, CCJ 230/301, and CCJ 240/303
 - May be satisfied if student chooses the following MHCC CJA courses to fill their recommended electives bucket:
 - CJA 111, CJA 112, and CJA 113.
- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** 8 credits of CCJ elective courses
 - May be satisfied if student takes an additional 8 credits of CJA MHCC courses to fill their recommended electives bucket.
