 PSU Transfer Tip: PSU requires 12 credits of Science; of which 8 credits of coursework must have a lab or fieldwork attached. Prioritize using 9 CR of Science/Math/Computer Science requirement to meet PSU's Science requirement.

MHCC Elective/University Requirement (9 credits)

- Must complete 9 CR in Elective¹/University Requirements.

Criminal Justice Administration AAS Degree Transfer Guide

All students must satisfy both Bachelor of Science degree requirements and Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) major requirements. Mt. Hood Community College students who complete an AAS degree in Criminal Justice Administration can generally expect their courses to transfer to the PSU Bachelor of Science and CCJ major as shown below.

I. AAS in Criminal Justice Administration Degree Application to PSU Bachelor of Science Degree Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 8 credit Writing requirement
 - WR121 & WR 227
 - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 12 credits in Social Science or Arts & Letters general education requirement
 - Met by a combination of AAS in Criminal Justice Administration required & elective courses
 - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU University Studies 15 credits Freshman Inquiry
 - Met by total AAS Criminal Justice Administration degree credits earned
 - ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 4 credit Math requirement
 - Met by required MTH 105 or higher course
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- **May Be Satisfied Depending on Credits Chosen:** PSU 12 credit Science requirement; of which 8 of the 12 credits must be coursework with a lab or fieldwork attached
 - Required GEOG 106 or GEOG 107 will satisfy 3 credits of non-lab science coursework.
 - May be satisfied **if** student utilizes 9 credits of required MHCC Science/Math/Computer Science coursework to complete remaining 9 credits needed of science coursework at PSU; of which 8 credits must be science coursework with a lab attached.
 - **May Be Satisfied Depending on Transfer Credits:** PSU University Studies 12 credits Sophomore Inquiry can be satisfied with transfer of 90 credits to PSU
 - Not all AAS in Criminal Justice Administration credits earned at Mt. Hood CC transfer to PSU because vocational, cooperation education, and physical education credits are capped at 12 transfer credits each. Transfer credits are determined by PSU Admissions.

II. AAS in Criminal Justice Degree Application to PSU Criminology & Criminal Justice (CCJ) Major Requirements

- ✓ **Satisfied:** PSU 3 CCJ required courses: 200/300, CCJ 230/301, and CCJ 240/303
 - Met by AAS in Criminal Justice Administration required courses CJA 111, CJA 112 and CJA 113.
 - 32 credits of required CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU
- ✓ **Satisfied:** 8 credits of CCJ elective courses
 - Met by a combination of required and elective CJA courses for AAS in Criminal Justice Administration
 - 16 credits of Upper Division elective CCJ courses remain to be completed through PSU
