IELP to host Fulbright Scholars

The Institute of International Education has selected Portland State's [Intensive English Language Program](#) to host Fulbright students for three weeks of English for graduate studies training. Beginning July 21, the IELP training program will prepare approximately 35 graduate students from a variety of countries and academic majors for the academic and cultural expectations they are likely to experience while studying in the United States. In addition to class work, they will engage in experiential learning opportunities before leaving Aug. 10 for their host universities.
