

ALTERNATIVE FORMATS TECHNICIAN (AFT) JOB APPLICATION

An Alternative Formats Technician works as part of a team of technicians and other staff within the Disability Resource Center's Alternative Format Lab to acquire, create, maintain, and distribute accessible, electronic formats of inaccessible print materials to students with disabilities.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- You **must be currently enrolled** for six undergraduate or five graduate credit hours in order to qualify for employment as a production technician in the Disability Resource Center.
- You must be available to work a **minimum of twenty hours per week** for the first five weeks of each academic term and a **minimum of fifteen hours per week** for the second five weeks of each academic term. More hours may be available during holiday seasons.
- Applications must be accompanied by a professional **résumé** and **cover letter**.
