Juniors Seniors Graduate Students This course offers a study tour trip to Lima, Peru and helps students to focus their learning within a dialogue framework with South American and U.S. Educators focused on the philosophies of Reggio Emilia through a network of diverse schools, La Casa Amarilla. Students visit many schools, work in the classrooms, attend workshops, engage in pedagogical encounters through daily dialogue with parents, teachers, and other educators developing different points of views with teachers and children with contrasting identities.

As a community of learners, we will explore together what it means to be deep thinkers in our practice. From Programa Transforma---in the hillside communities of Lima----to the schools in the city center, this study tour will work along side the teachers, children, and parents of the explore learner centered education with children, 3-5 years of age. With over 50 hours of contact in the schools, through PSU classes and on site workshops, we exploring young children's learning through interactions with intentional environments.
