- JR- EHS Air Quality Response in Cramer Hall
  - EHS is able to deploy an Air Advice Monitor unit
  - The monitor tracks particulate matter (PM 10), Total Volatile Organic Compounds (TVOCs), Carbon Dioxide (CO2), Carbon Monoxide (CO), and temperature
  - Acceptable averages
    - PM Averages under 25µg/m<sup>3</sup> are considered acceptable
    - VOCs Averages under 3,000µg/m<sup>3</sup> are considered acceptable
    - CO2 Averages under 1,200 ppm are considered acceptable
    - CO Averages under 9 ppm are considered acceptable
    - Temperature Ranges 68° to 74° during occupied times are considered acceptable
  - $\circ$   $\;$  If there is any concern regarding air quality, file a work order through FPM  $\;$

  - $\circ$   $\;$  Vouchers for COVID testing are still available for employees if needed
    - PSU is still looking into contracting a company for onsite testing
