Chemical Storage

- Best Practices for Chemical Storage are critical to ensure the community safety. Make sure your lab is up to date in the PSU Chemical Inventory
- Maintain the safe and responsible use of chemicals, including waste, in an academic research setting, in line with state and federal regulations.
- Always consult your SDS for specific storage and segregation requirements for your chemicals and chemical hazardous waste.
- Store in groups based on their compatibility. Do not store your chemicals in alphabetical order, except within each hazard family.
