It was moved (Rissi) and seconded (Randol) to approve this proposal. The motion was approved unanimously.

#### Discussion: Distinction between MA and MS degrees

Hanson shared that the Graduate School is working on a proposal to eliminate the second language requirements for the MA degree. PSU currently defines the difference between the MA and MS as the second language requirement; if this requirement is eliminated, some other university-level distinction between the MA and MS will need to be created. The Graduate School asked members for their thoughts on possible distinctions.

- The MA being more arts and letters focused, and the MS being more science/math/engineering focused, was discussed as a straightforward distinction.
- The MS requiring some sort of math or statistics requirement was discussed.
- One degree being more theoretical, and the other being more applied/practical, was
  discussed. It was acknowledged that which way this distinction goes may vary by discipline,
  so creating a university-level difference based on this criterion could be problematic.
- Members from departments that offer both an MA and MS stated there is not much difference in prestige or advantage on the job market with one degree or the other.
