HOMELESSNESS RESEARCH AND POLICY ROUNDTABLE

Portland State University's Homelessness Research & Action Collaborative Roundtable Discussion with Oregon's Senator Jeff Merkley on homelessness research and policy.

Agenda:

- **Welcome:** Center Director Dr. Marisa Zapata welcomes participants and provides background on the research center and its work to address homelessness.
- **National Policy:** Oregon's Senator Jeff Merkley shares information about the Affordable HOME Act and the latest on the second infrastructure bill currently making its way through the reconciliation process. Sen. Merkley is working to include key provisions from his legislation in the bill.
- Evictions Research: Evictions play a key role in causing and perpetuating homelessness. Faculty Researcher Dr. Lisa K. Bates will discuss her evictions research and the downstream costs of evictions to local, state and the federal government and taxpayers.
- Emergency/disaster response for those living unsheltered: People living unsheltered were deeply impacted by the 2020 wildfire season yet received little assistance and in some cases were turned away. Our survey of people experiencing homelessness looks at the gaps while a research analysis examines the ways society uses language and how it might influence who gets help. Center Co-Founder Dr. Maude Hines and Graduate Research Assistant Emily Leickly discuss the findings.
- Homelessness in higher education: The center's survey of PSU students shows that one in six students experienced homelessness in a given year. It underscores a national reality that homelessness, housing insecurity, and basic needs insecurity is a part of the college experience for many students. Center Co-Founder Dr. Greg Townley and Dr. Katricia Stewart, a recent graduate of PSU, will share the findings. Student Research Assistant Shaun Hardy will share his experience and his involvement in a project sharing stories of students experiencing homelessness through comics in order to change the narrative about homelessness.
