Description of Services

Works with local governments and law enforcement agencies to **clean up** and investigate illegally dumped trash on public lands across the Metro region. In November 2018, RID Patrol launched a **trash collection** pilot with the goal of providing trash collection options for people experiencing homelessness.

HUCIRP runs the One Point of Contact Campsite reporting system and responds to reports of **unsanctioned urban camps**, **garbage**, **and people living in vehicles**. HUCIRP works with several partners including social services, PBOT's vehicle inspection team, BDS Code Enforcement Team, and police to help address these issues.

A mentored work experience that provides **cleanup services** at designated camping areas within the City of Portland. The program also manages a **day use storage** unit in downtown Portland.

Programs focused on developing special facilities featuring **systems of care** that meet the broad needs of the chronically homeless and unsheltered. In addition to a **central navigation center**, Harbor of Hope is partnering with CCC to provide **Mobile Shower & Laundry Trucks** that will operate 5 days/week with stops scheduled at schools, churches, and encampments.

Provides individuals with the **services**, **resources**, **and tools** they need to end their homelessness and to secure and maintain housing. TPI's Resource Center located in the Bud Clark Commons provides **restrooms**, **showers**, **and laundry facilities** in addition to a host of other services to those experiencing homelessness.

A project of the People's Harm Reduction Alliance, this all-volunteer organization provides clean syringes, Narcan & other harm reduction supplies directly to users.


