# FALL 2025 MOVE-IN GUIDE

# Welcome to Portland State University!

To help you prepare for move-in, we have organized some information that we think will be most beneficial.

# PLAN AHEAD

# GET YOUR PSU ID CARD

**Pick up your PSU ID Card Prior to your move-in date.** Your PSU Student ID grants you access to your residence hall and building elevator, and lets you use your meal plan if you have one.

- You will need a valid government issued photo ID to get your ID card.
- ID Services is located in Fariborz Maseeh Hall, and is open Monday through Friday, 9am 5pm.
- If you are unable to get your ID card prior to move-in, you can use a valid government issued ID to check-in. We will provide you a temporary key fob to access your residence hall. You will be expected to go to ID Services the next day they open to pick up your ID card and return your temporary fob.

# **STEPS FOR MOVING IN**

SELECT TIMESLOT Select a check-in timeslot through the Housing Portal (pdx.edu/ housing/portal)

You can change your timeslot as needed prior to arrival.

> Please leave your belongings in your car until after you have checked in and received your keys.

# **BRINGING A CAR TO CAMPUS?**

Most residents will not keep a car on campus since public transit is so accessible and convenient. If you are bringing your car to campus, you may purchase a residential parking permit from Transportation and Parking Services online. Select a residence hall permit.

# CONNECT WITH YOUR ROOMMATE

You will receive room and roommate information in late August. Once you get contact details for your roommate, introduce yourself! You can avoid duplicate items by coordinating who will bring what.

# CHECK YOUR PSU EMAIL

Be sure to check your PSU email regularly for important updates and information about your community.

# 3 CHECK-IN

Go to designated Check-in location during your chosen timeslot.

Bring your PSU ID card or a government issued photo ID to pick up move-in folder and keys.

# INSPECT ROOM & MOVE IN

We make every effort to make sure your room is prepared for you. In the case of any damages, please email **housing@pdx.edu** within 48 hours so they can be addressed and so you are not billed for damages on move-out.

# **DINING ON CAMPUS**

Dining plans begin with lunch on September 25th. All First Year Experience students are enrolled in a dining plan as part of their contract.

### PACKAGES

Our package room has limited space. Please do not mail packages prior to arrival. Students who need to mail many large boxes to campus should utilize a pick-up service at USPS or UPS.

Information about your mailing address is included on your assignment details sent in August. You will need to include your room number on all mail and packages.

# FOR A SMOOTHER MOVE - IN

We recommend you bring a wagon or handtruck to help with the move-in process. We have a limited number of carts available. We recommend that residents avoid bringing U-Hauls or large box trucks as there will be limited street parking.

# **ELEVATORS**

Elevators are available in Blumel, Broadway, Montgomery, Ondine, and Stephen Epler. St. Helens has no elevators. There may be long waits for the elevators during move-in. So we recommend using stairs, if you are able.

# ALL UTILITIES INCLUDED

Rates include electricity, gas, water, sewer, garbage, and internet. Wireless internet is available in all buildings. Ethernet ports are available in Blumel, Broadway, Ondine, and Stephen Epler.

# **CHECK-IN DETAILS**

Residents will not be able to check-in prior to the check-in timeslot they have chosen via the Housing Portal. There is no time limit for moving in.

The Broadway Service Desk is open each day until midnight for any late check-ins.

#### **FURNISHING IN YOUR ROOM**

- All units come with a bed, dresser, desk, and chair for each resident
- Twin XL Mattress: Broadway, Ondine, St. Helens, Montgomery
- Standard Twin Mattress: Blumel, Epler
- Barstools are provided in Blumel and St. Helens
- Units may have two sets of furniture; Some single units extra furniture cannot be removed
- Units with kitchens or kitchenettes include fridges or mini-fridges
- Sleeper units include a mini fridge and microwave

# **PARKING INFORMATION**

# **Ondine and Broadway Residents**

Parking Structure 1 Address: 1872 SW Broadway, Portland, OR 97201

Residents checking in on **September 25 (9am - 4:30pm)** will receive a 75-minute active loading zone permit to be used on levels 1 and 2 in Parking Structure 1. Permits will be available at the parking structure upon arrival. After the loading zone permit expires, residents must move their vehicle to levels 3 and up and pay for parking.

- 1. Go to Parking Structure 1 (level 1 or 2) to park
- 2. Receive loading zone permit and place face up on dashboard
- 3. Go to Check-in Location and pick-up keys
- 4. Move items to room
- 5. Return to car within 75 minutes and move to regular parking

After 4:30pm September 25, active loading zone permits will not be available. Residents can park in Parking Structure 1 and pay at a kiosk or with Parking Kitty app.

# Blumel, Montgomery, Stephen Epler, and St. Helens Residents

#### Parking Structure 3

Address: 1631 SW 12th Ave, Portland, OR 97201

Residents are encouraged to use Parking Structure 3. Please note the height clearance is 6'3", which may be too short for some standard pick-up trucks. If your vehicle exceeds this height, Blumel Parking Lot may be an option and has a height clearance of 7'1". If you are bringing a Uhaul or other large commercial moving truck, please consider street parking or renting a van.

- 1. Go to Parking Structure 3 to park
- 2. Pay at a kiosk or with Parking Kitty app
- 3. Go to Check-in Location and pick-up keys
- 4. Move items to room
