

MEDICAID BENEFICIARIES

Medicaid provides access to community-based care (CBC) for low-income adults and people with disabilities. CBC includes assisted living facilities, residential care facilities, memory care communities, and adult foster homes.

There were 14,809 Medicaid clients age 18 and over whose last residence in FY 2013-14 was a CBC setting.





Medicaid clients who were 90 years of age or older were admitted to the hospital at a lower rate (5%) than younger clients and about **31%** had at least one emergency department visit during the past year.
