



% of RC RESIDENTS NEEDING STAFF ASSISTANCE IN OREGON & NATIONALLY¹








FACILITY POLICIES, RATES, and STAFFING



Oregon DHS contracted Portland State University's Institute on Aging to survey all AL, RC, & MC communities in 2016. Results are based on provider responses to a questionnaire that was mailed in December 2016. Some questions asked for current information while others asked about events that occurred during the prior 90 days. As responses were received through March of 2017, the time period for responses varies from October 2016 through March 2017. A total of 164 residential care communities with 1,523 residents responded for a 55% response rate.
