

# Oregon's Family Child Care Scholarship

## Policies

You must be the Provider named on an Oregon Registered Family or Certified Family Child Care license.

Scholarships are available first come, first served for a total determined by scholarship type (college coursework, training, conference, or credential). You may apply more than once until you reach the limit allowed for one scholarship type.

Please select your scholarship type carefully because you can only receive awards for one scholarship type. See the table for a comparison of scholarship types.

You may choose to apply for a voucher or a reimbursement. A voucher is like a check that you give the college/organization before you begin the professional development activity. A reimbursement (check or direct deposit) goes directly to you after you have already completed and paid for the professional development activity.
