Topic: Welcome

Topic: Review of meeting notes from 12/16/16 meeting

**Action:** The meeting notes were approved without revision and are ready for posting to the website.

Topic: Campus classroom door locks (Heather Randol, Mark Wubbold)

**Discussion:** VP FADM has asked the CPSC to research the pros and cons of locks on classroom doors. A CPSC work group presented their initial research to the committee. Highlights include:

- Explanation of the three main options for door locks
- A literature review of national standards for classroom door locks
- Outcome of an interview with PSU's locksmith
- National discussion of the use of Barricades (although most jurisdictions prohibit these by code, there are states that are experimenting with their use in classrooms.)
- Electronic locking systems already under the control of CPSO
- The process our peers (U of O and OSU) are experimenting with that enable individual departments to add internally locking doors to their classrooms

Action: The CPSC work group will develop a briefing document summarizing their research for the next meeting.

Topic: Title IX Presentation (Julie Caron)

**Discussion:** Associate VP Julie Caron, director of equity and compliance in the Office of Global Diversity and Inclusion, presented a Powerpoint on PSU's Title IX program. Her presentation covered the following:

- Explanation of the Title IX statute and what it covers, beginning with Sexual Harassment
- Title IX data collection
- Guidance from the Office of Civil Rights
- The Clery and Campus SaVE acts
- Title IX and the PSU Student Code of Conduct
- University reporting obligations and the concept of "responsible employees"
- Services for Victims
- Trauma Informed Advocacy
- The role of CPSO in Title IX compliance
- PSU's Title IX compliance process
- The University's Title IX complaint procedures and obligations
