**Campus Public Safety Committee (CPSC) – March 16, 2018**

**Convened:** 1:05 pm

**Topic:** Welcome and review of meeting notes.

**Discussion:** CPSC approved the 2/16/18 meeting notes without changes.

**Action:** Staff will post the notes to the Committee’s website.

**Topic:** CPSC tour of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) (Chief Tanksley/Lt. Whitten)

**Discussion:** Continuing education is a CPSC standard. The EOC tour helped the committee better understand the university’s emergency management processes. Lt. Craig Whitten demonstrated some of the features of the EOC and explained recent improvements.

**Topic:** EOC and Dispatch Briefing (Chief Tanksley/Lt. Whitten)

**Discussion:** Chief Tanksley and Lt. Craig Whitten talked a bit more about the EOC, and the role of campus dispatch in CPSO’s operations. They both expressed a desire to increase training for campus dispatchers. They also explained that since campus dispatch is not part of the emergency 911-dispatch system, their training options are limited. When it comes to training, emergency 911 dispatchers have priority. CPSC members are interested in learning what it would take to have campus dispatch recognized as 911 emergency dispatchers.

CPSC listened to an audio recording of Umpqua Community College’s dispatch communications during their campus shooting. Committee members noted the level of professionalism, precision, and calm required by dispatch staff in an emergency situation.

**Topic:** CPSO Tour

**Discussion:** CPSC then toured the Campus Public Safety Office and had an opportunity to observe dispatch operations as well as had a Q&A with two of CPSO's dispatchers.
