Integrative Field Experience (6 credits)

Students' program of study culminates in an Integrative Field Experience, a community-based capstone project. PA 509 Organizational Experience is required for all MNL students. It provides students with an opportunity to solidify what has been learned throughout the program with a hands-on project aimed at helping a nonprofit or grassroots organization build its capacity. It is available to students **only after they have completed 42 credits** in their master's program.
