# Statement of Intent Questions

#### 1. Your organizational experience

What made these leadership challenges complex and perhaps intractable? What were the human, inter-organizational, intra-organizational, and inter-jurisdictional, multiple stakeholder and other dimensions of the challenges? How did you deal with these challenges and what lessons have you learned from these experiences? In what ways do you think the EMPA degree will better prepare you for dealing with such challenges in the future? What leadership knowledge, skills and competencies do you hope to gain and to add to your existing repertoire of leadership competencies?

What do you see as the trajectory of your career in the years ahead? What are your goals and aspirations? What do you want to learn and why? How do you envision the EMPA Program contribution to these goals, aspirations and learning objectives?
