- Resolve conflicts and sportsmanship problems when they arise
- Assist with the set-up and breakdown of the playing areas
- Work various games as a scorekeeper when needed
- Attend staff meetings
- Work tabling shifts to help promote program offerings and answer questions.

- Function and communicate effectively and respectfully within the context of varying beliefs, behaviors, orientations, identities, body sizes, abilities, and cultural backgrounds
- Maintain any valid certifications that is required of your position.

- Arrive to game site 30 minutes prior to when scheduled games are to be played
- Available in the evenings Sunday through Thursday

- Ability to respond to emergency situations

- Strong communication skills
- Available in the evenings on league night each academic term Monday through Thursday
- Attend mandatory trainings before each season
- Must successfully complete a background check
