

## Yellow Ribbon Program Post-9/11 GI Bill® Policy and Procedures

Portland State University (PSU) participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program (YRP), part of the Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33). Eligibility for the YRP benefit at PSU is limited to admitted, undergraduate and graduate students in good standing.

Please Note: This benefit is not applicable to postbac students. It is intended for first time undergraduate and graduate students only.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- You must be an admitted undergraduate or graduate student, in good standing, enrolled in degree applicable, credit bearing courses at PSU.
- You cannot be in academic dismissal status or have a student conduct registration restriction.
- You must have a Post-9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33) 100% Certificate of Eligibility, showing Yellow Ribbon Program eligibility.

### **Required Documents:**

- Ch. 33 Financial Agreement
- your VA Certificate of Eligibility, (showing YRP eligibility), and
- the PSU Veteran Course Description and Certification form

### **Maintaining Eligibility:**

If you do not receive the YRP award for a term because you do not register for courses, are academically dismissed or cannot register due to a student conduct violation or other registration hold, you will be removed from the Yellow Ribbon Program.
