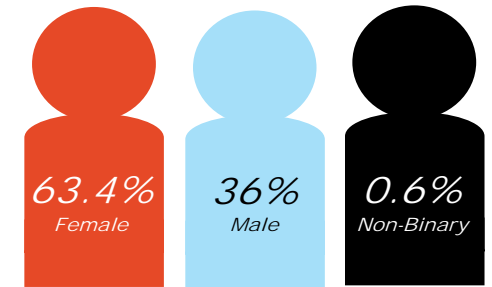

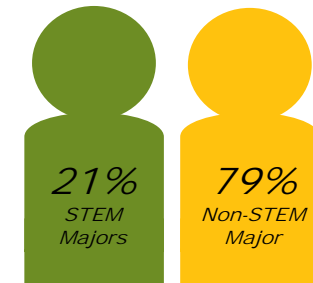

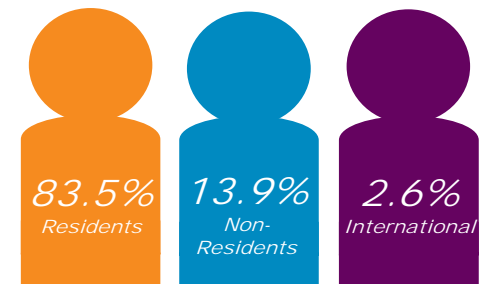

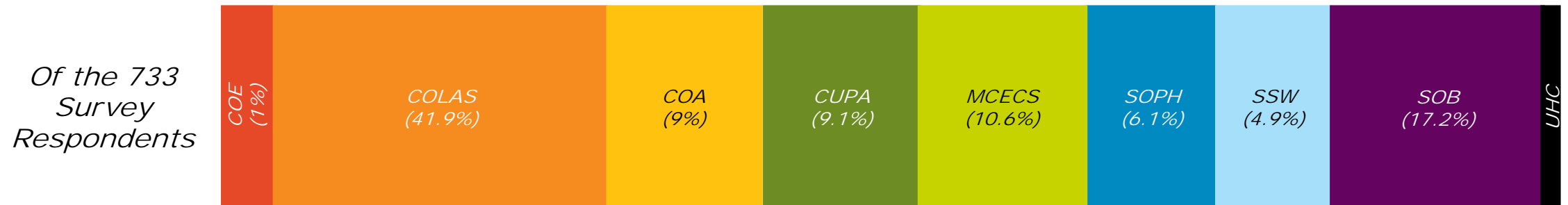

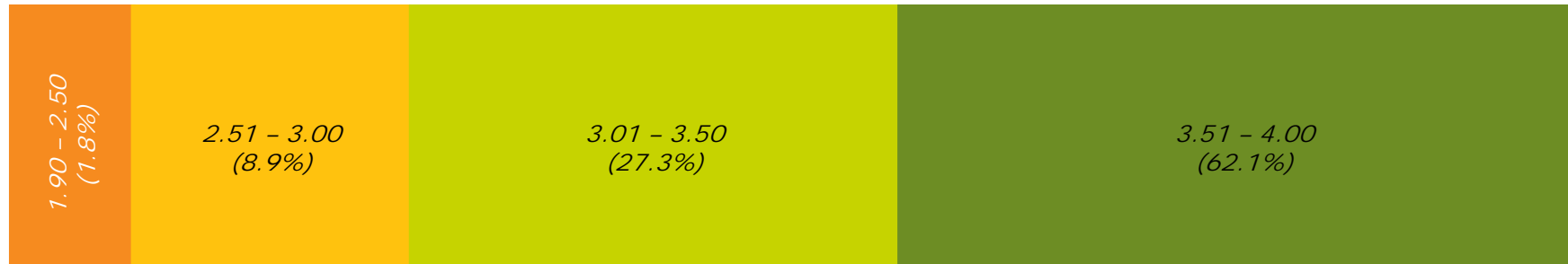

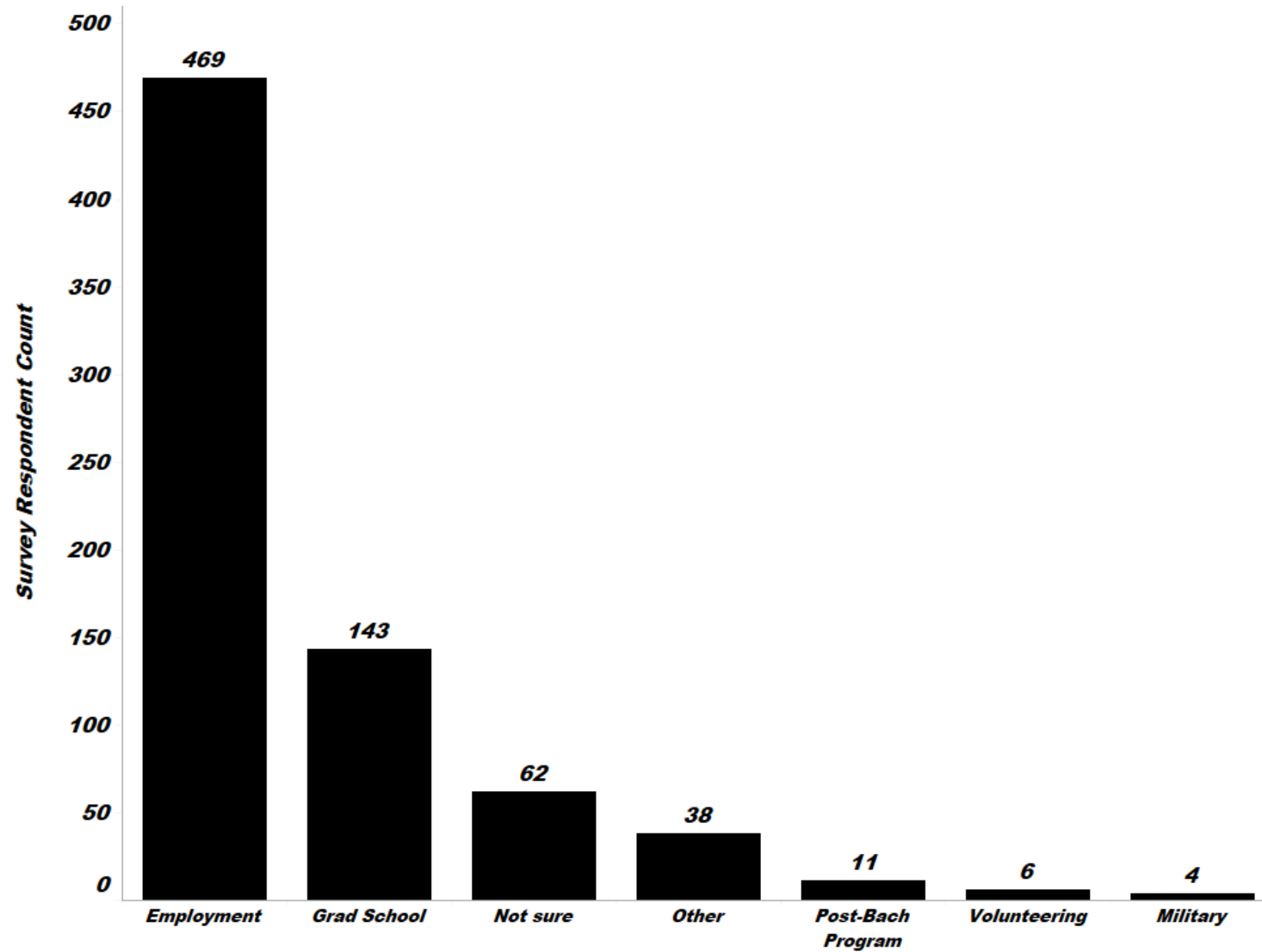

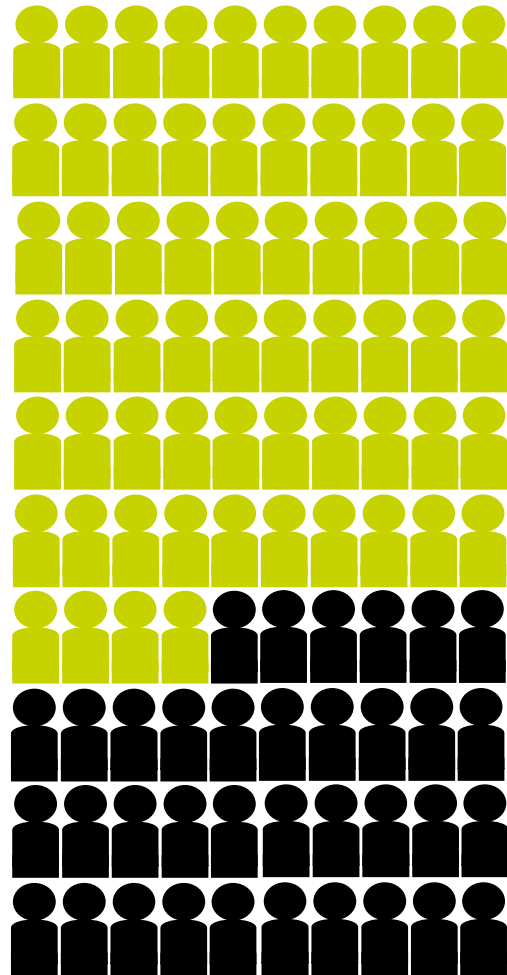


*Question 1:
What will be your MAIN activity after graduating from PSU?*



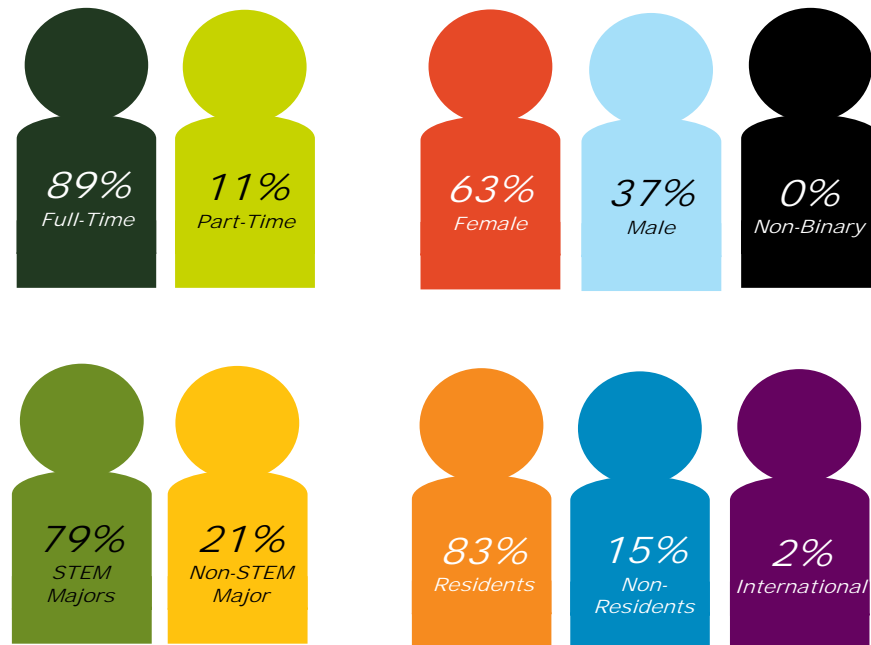


PAID EMPLOYMENT



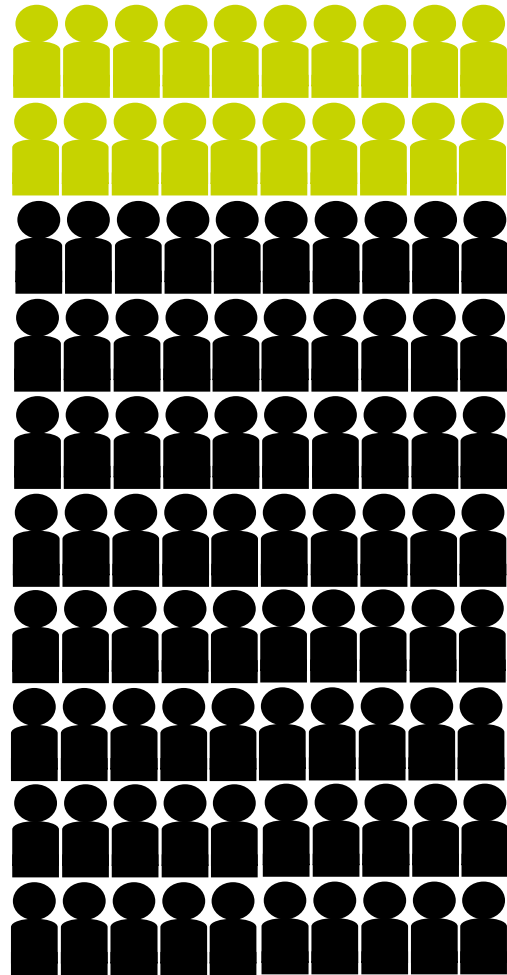
64% of students plan to be employed after graduation.

GRADUATE SCHOOL



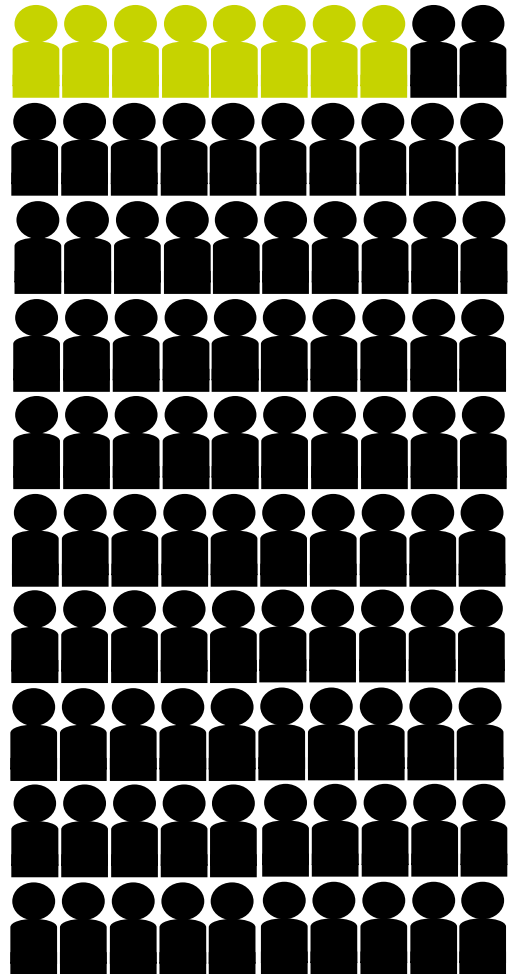
20% of students plan to enroll in a graduate/professional program after graduation.

Of this 20%...



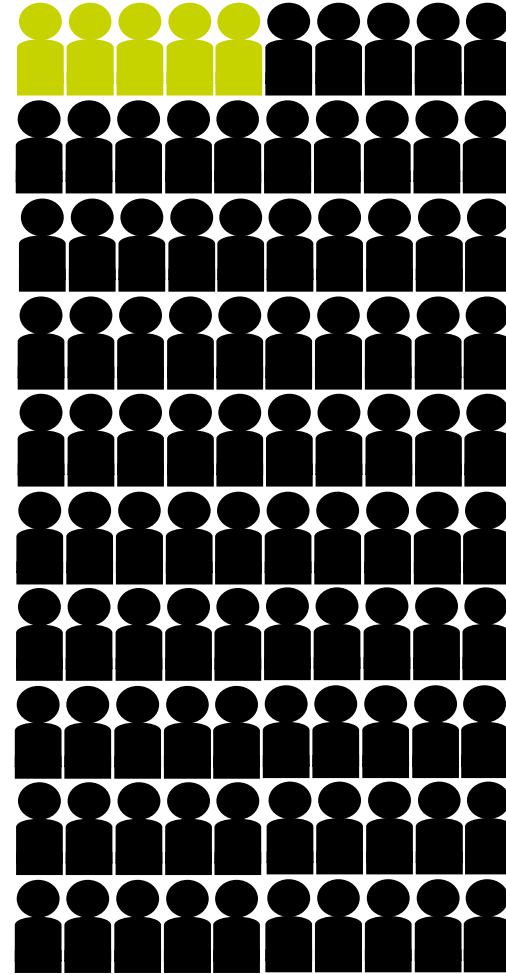

9% of students are considering one or more jobs offers.

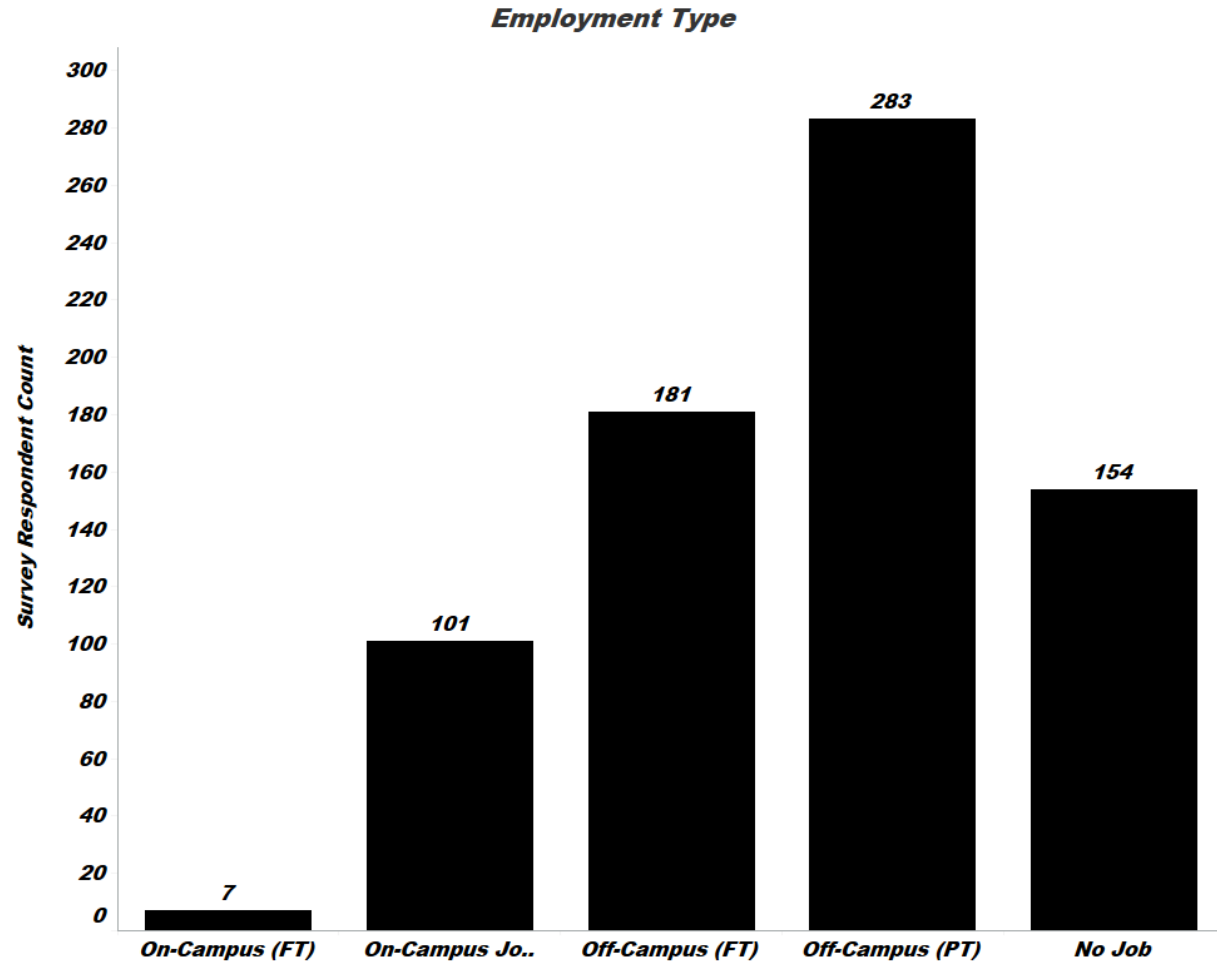
23% of students plan to remain in their current positions.

24% of students plan to accept a new position.

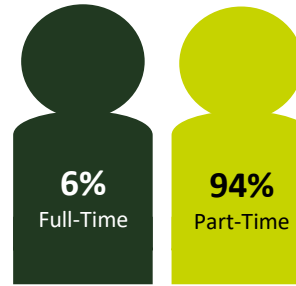
45% of students plan to start searching for a new position.

While you were enrolled at PSU, were you employed for pay (FT = 40 hrs/week)?

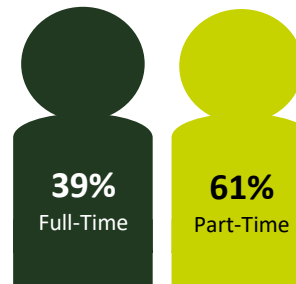


On-Campus

14% of students expect to be accepted into a graduate/professional program.

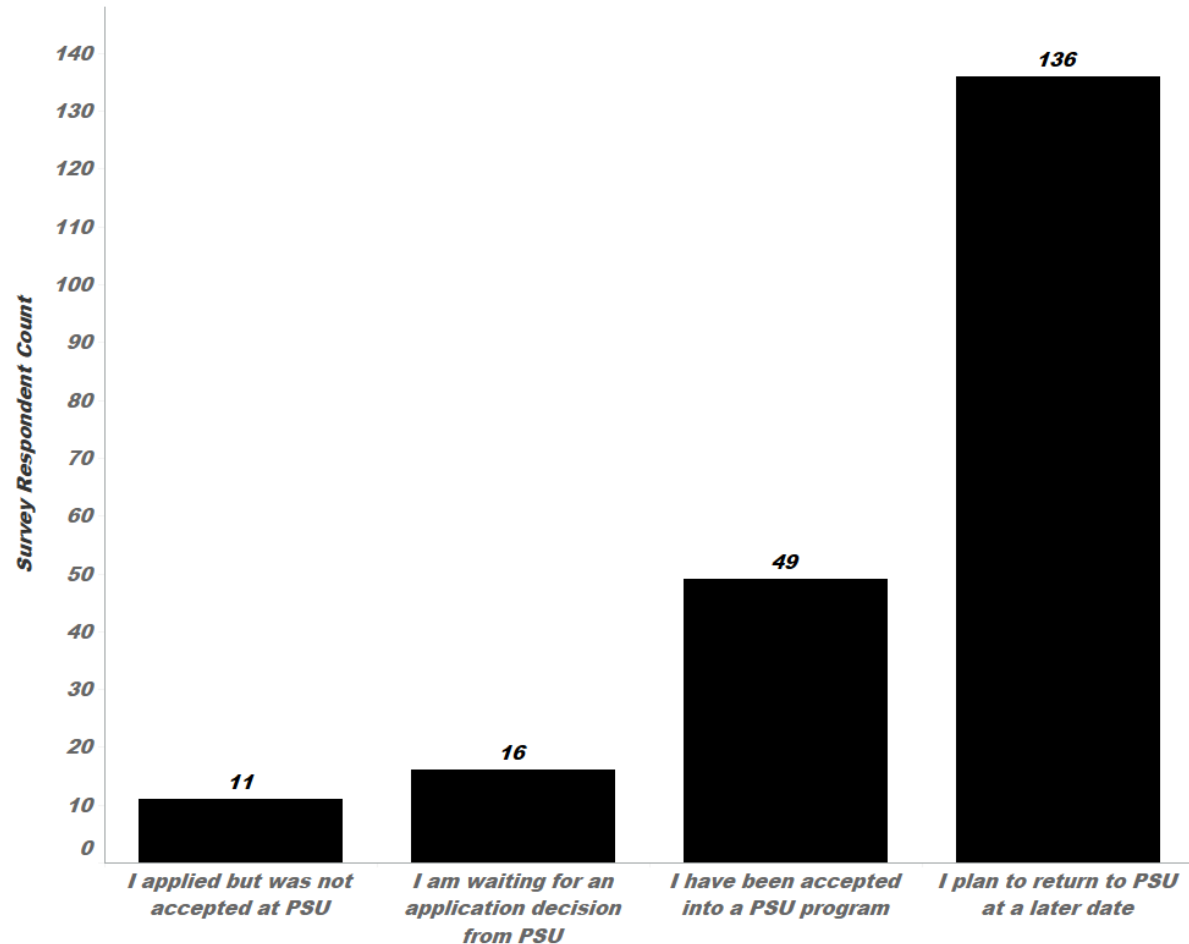
4% have applied for grad school and are still waiting on a decision.

46% plan to attend grad/professional school at a later date.

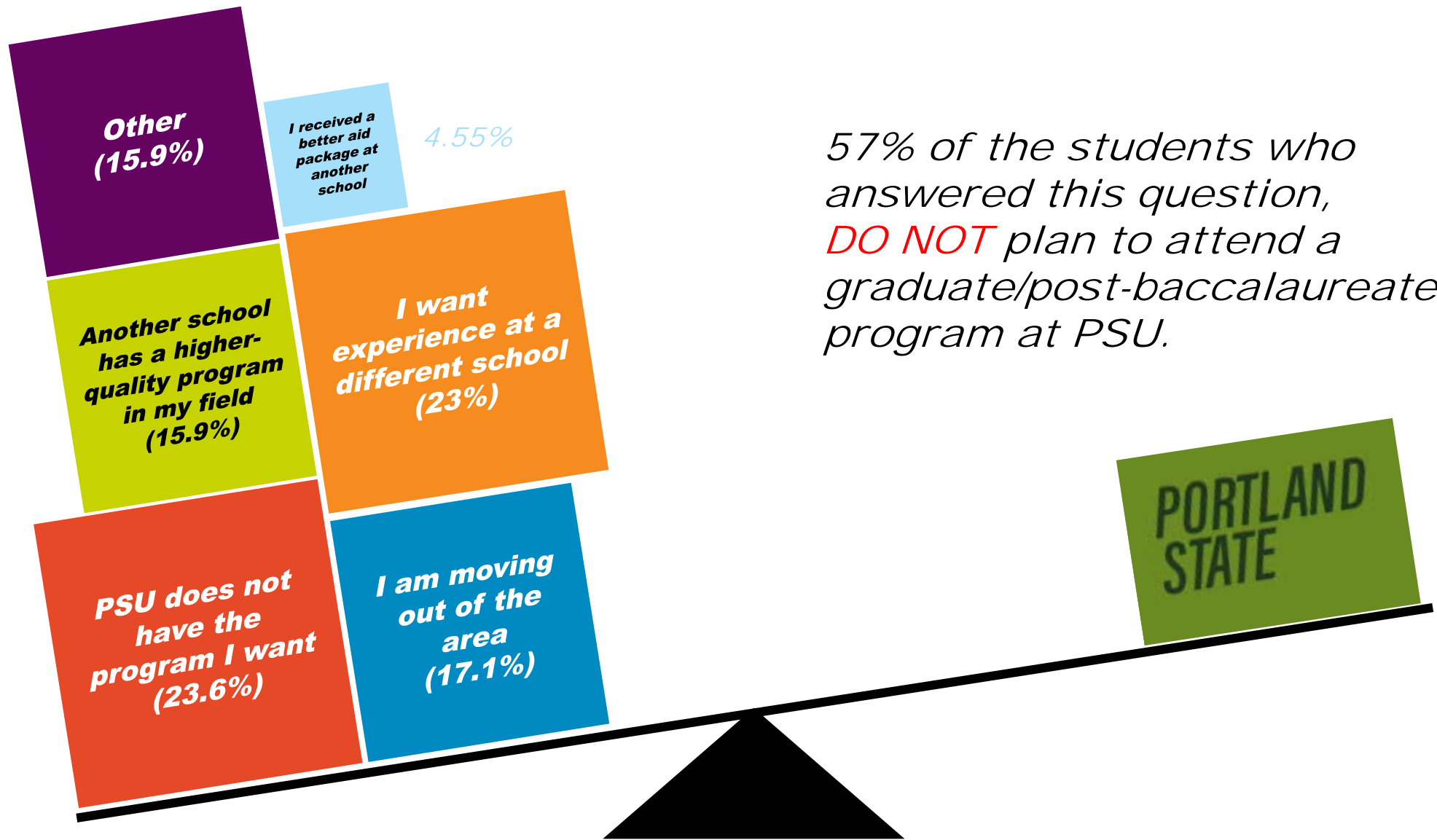
32% have no plans to continue their education.

Of the 43% of students who answered this question...

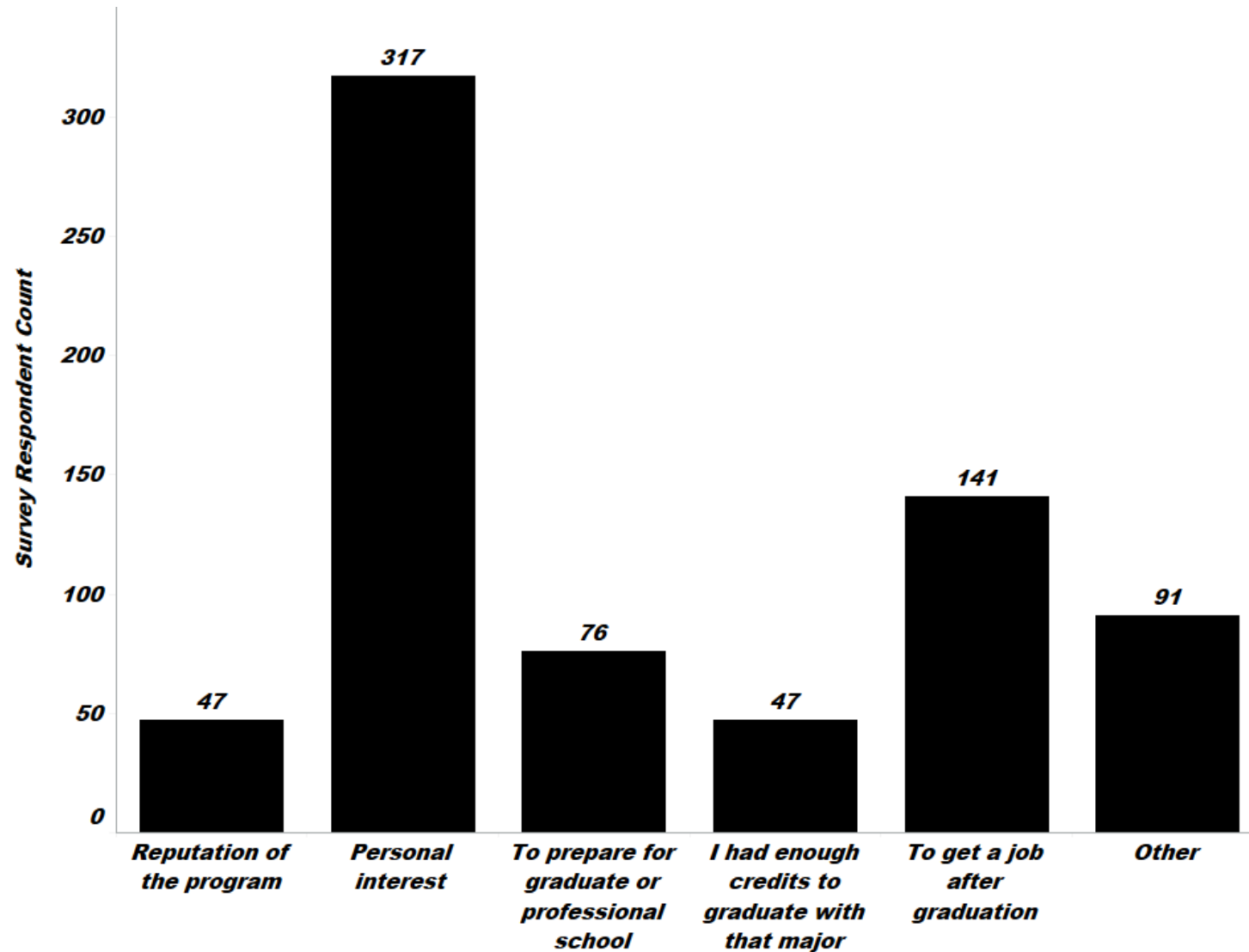
- 5% applied but were not accepted into PSU*

57% of the students who answered this question, **DO NOT** plan to attend a graduate/post-baccalaureate program at PSU.

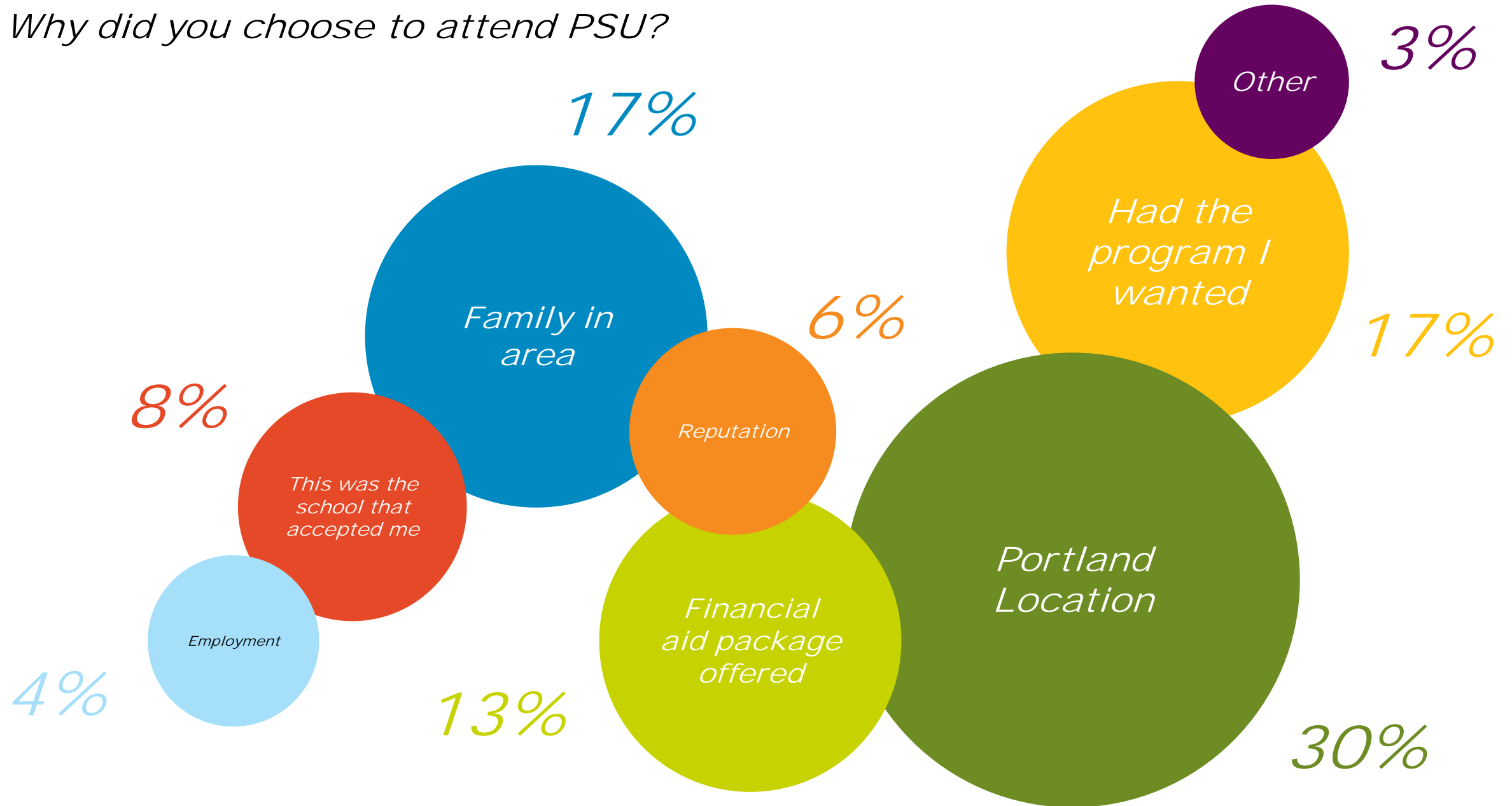
Question 4:

What was the PRIMARY reason you chose your undergraduate major or degree program at PSU?



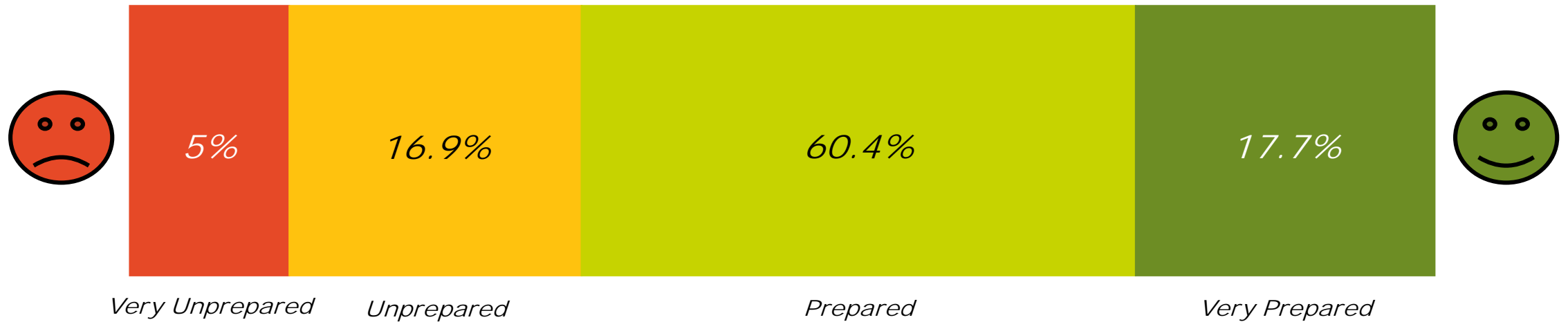


*Question 5:

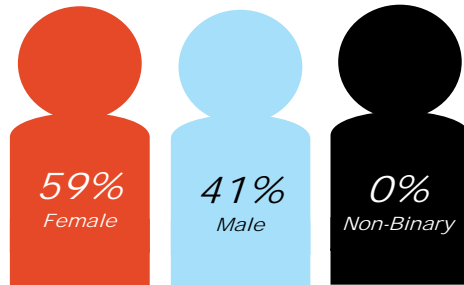

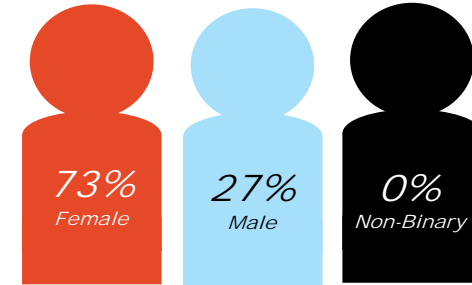

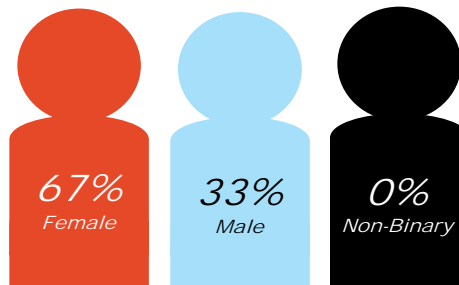

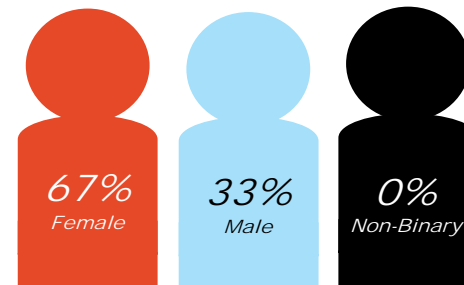

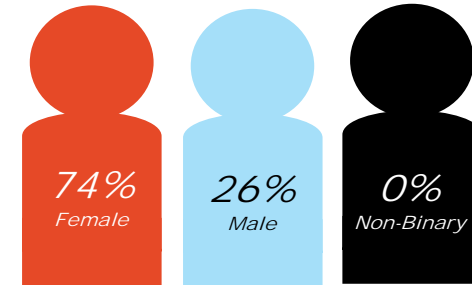

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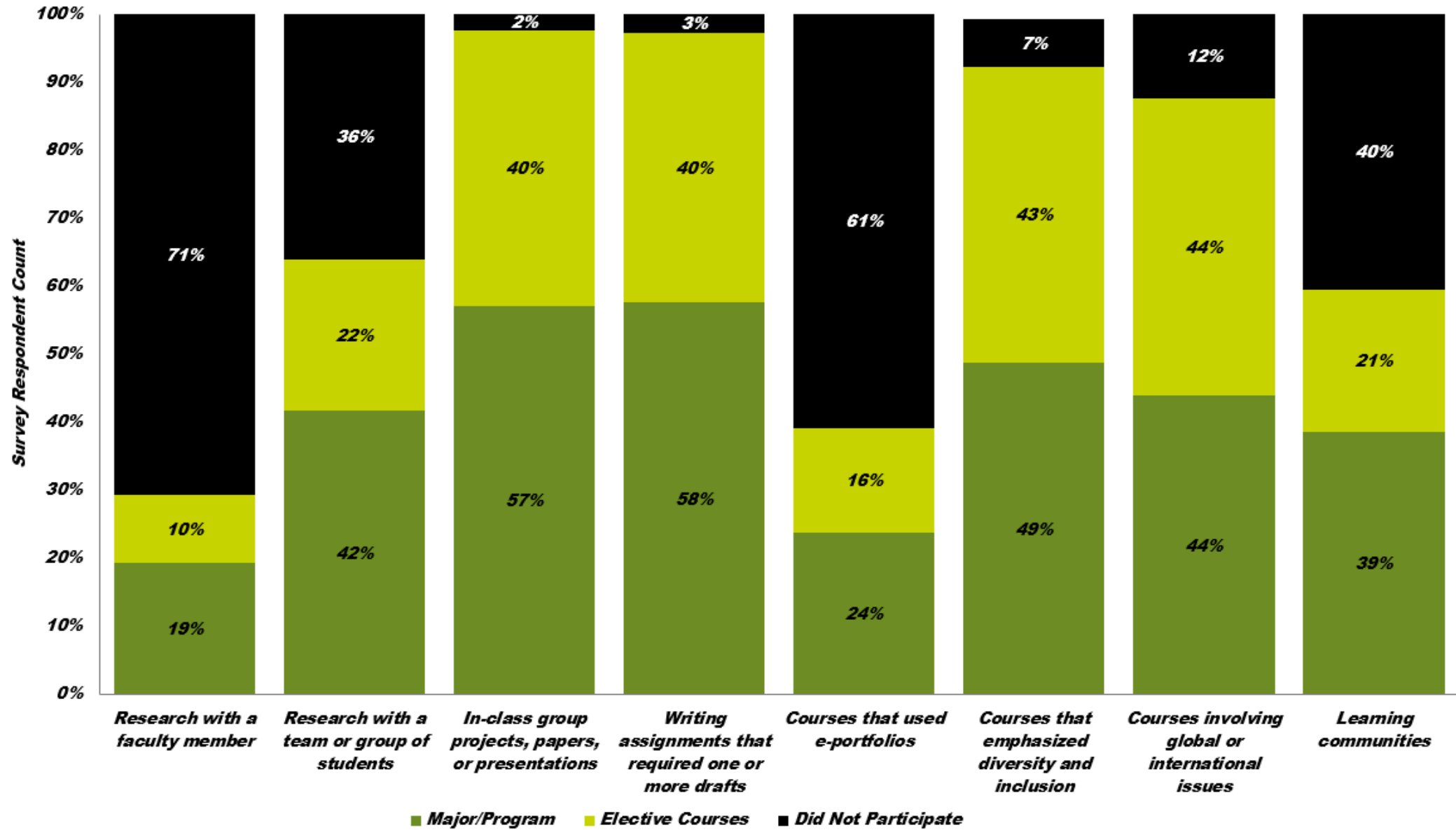

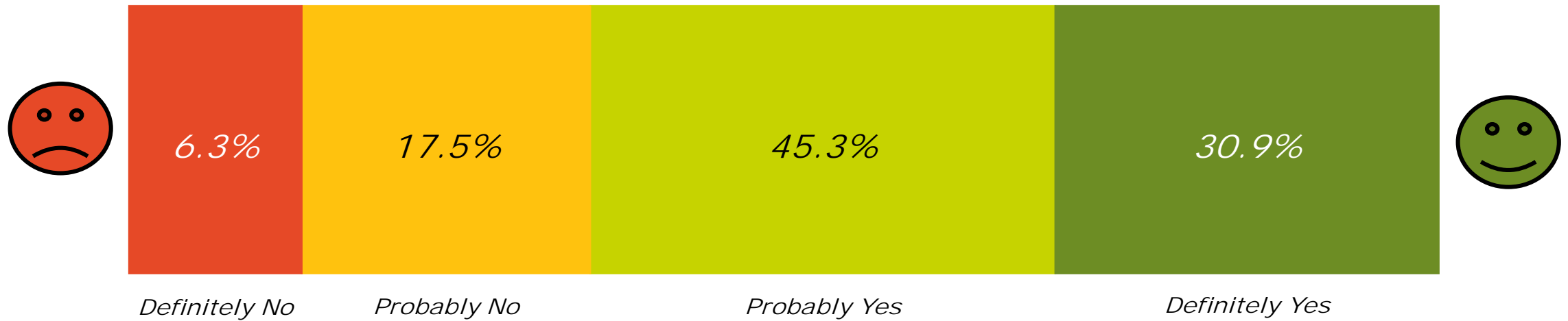


*Question 10:

CONCLUSIONS CONTINUED...

Courses with the highest participation:

- *Courses with in-class group projects, papers, presentations*
- *Courses with writing assignments that required one or more drafts*
- *Courses that emphasized diversity/inclusion*

Courses with the lowest participation:

- *Research with a faculty member*
- *Courses that used e-portfolios*

Courses appear to be taken more for major/program credit than elective.

Overall experience at PSU has been positive for most students.
