2020-2021 WAGS/PROQUEST INNOVATION IN TECHNOLOGY AWARD

The Western Association of Graduate Schools (WAGS) and ProQuest have announced the 2020-2021 WAGS-ProQuest Innovation in Technology award.

Each member institution may submit only one nomination for this award.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

This award may be given to a master's thesis or to a doctoral dissertation for the development of an innovative technology and its utilization for the creative solution of a major problem. The university nomination requires a written endorsement from the Dean of the Graduate School.

GUIDELINES FOR PSU PARTICIPATION IN THE 2020-2021 WAGS/PROQUEST INNOVATION IN TECHNOLOGY AWARD

- I. To be nominated, the student must have been graduated with a master's or doctoral degree in Summer or Fall 2019 or Winter or Spring 2020, with the thesis or dissertation as the culminating activity for the degree. Nomination materials must be submitted to the PSU Graduate School and must include the following:
 - a. A non-technical summary prepared by the student (1000-1500 words) describing the research and how it demonstrates or resulted in the development of innovative technology in the conduct of scholarship. This summary should be directed to a general academic audience of non-specialists.
 - b. An abstract of the thesis (not to exceed 10 double-spaced pages). Appendices containing nontextual material, such as charts or tables, may be included as additional pages. All pages should be numbered, and each should bear the name of the student.
 - c. A letter from the thesis adviser *or* the department chair *plus* a letter from one additional faculty member, each on department letterhead. These letters should include information regarding the significance of the study, the contribution of the study to the program or the degree granting unit, and the impact of the thesis on the knowledge base of the discipline.
 - d. A CV or résumé from the student nominee (not to exceed five pages).

Submit all application materials in electronic format (MS Word only) to hanson@pdx.edu. Please include "WAGS nomination" and the nominee's name in the subject line of the email.

2. **All nomination materials must be received by the Graduate School no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 3, 2020.** One nominated thesis will be selected by the Dean of the Graduate School for forwarding to the WAGS competition.
3. Evaluation will be based on the following criteria: originality of the study, scope and significance of the study, contributions to the discipline and/or profession, and overall quality of the summary and abstract of the thesis. Awards will be determined in November 2020.
4. The 2020-21 winner will receive a certificate of award, \$1,000, and travel expenses for the recipient to attend the WAGS Annual Conference and Awards luncheon to be held in Boise, ID in March 2021.
