Stroke Camp Northwest

Stroke Camp is an interdisciplinary endeavor partnering faculty and students from PSU and Pacific University. It results in a unique opportunity for speech language pathology, occupational therapy and physical therapy students to serve stroke survivors with aphasia and their family caregivers.
