### **Population Growth in Oregon: 2000-2009**

Oregon's state population is estimated to have been 3,823,465 on July 1, 2009. This represents an increase of 402,066 from the April 1, 2000 Census count, and 32,390 from the 2008 estimate.

The average annual population growth rate from April 2000 to 2009 in Oregon is 1.2 percent. The rate of population change increased each year during the first half of the decade although not quite reaching rates as high as seen during the early and mid-1990s. Around 2006-2007 the trend reversed itself and population growth decelerated to just under one percent from 2008 to 2009.

Despite the turnaround in growth trends, yearly rates have not dropped as low as those in the 1980s. Typically, the rate of population growth in Oregon has corresponded to trends in the economy. In strong economic times, Oregon has experienced higher rates of growth, and during a recessive economy, growth rates tend to be lower. (See Figure 2 on page 26.)

Population growth consists of two factors: net migration (movers in minus movers out) and natural increase (births minus deaths). Since 1988, Oregon's population growth has been more dependent on the net in-migration of people rather than on natural increase, and a drop in net migration has corresponded to a decline in annual population growth rates. Between April 1, 2000 and July 1, 2009, Oregon is estimated to have added 254,326 persons due to net migration, which accounts for 63 percent of the period's total population growth. From 1990 to 2000 that percentage was 73 percent, but last year, net migration accounted for about half of the state's population growth.

As mentioned above, migration to and from Oregon is primarily driven by the state of the economy. When the economy is strong, net in-migration elevates as people move here to take advantage of employment opportunities. When the economy goes into recession, in-migration flows slow down. In the current decade, however, despite times of high unemployment rates experienced in Oregon, there still are positive inflows of migration (see Figure 3 on page 27). People whose primary motivations are not so economically oriented continue to move to Oregon; among them are college-educated outdoor minded young adults, retirees, and immigrants.

Thirty-seven percent of Oregon's population growth from 2000 to 2009 was due to natural increase. During the past year, natural increase accounted for about 50 percent of the State's population increase, reaching the highest share of population growth in ten years. By comparison, natural increase contributed 27 percent of Oregon's added population from 1990 to 2000. For the past three years, the number of births has had a rising influence on Oregon's population growth. However, this is not due to

an increase in the number of annual births, but rather to the yearly decline in the number of net migrants. The number of yearly births that have occurred each year since 2000 ranges from 45,000 – 49,500; during the 1990s the number fluctuated between 41,000 and 45,000. The number of annual deaths during the decade has remained more stable. During 2000 to 2009, a range of around 30,000 to just over 31,500 deaths to Oregon residents have occurred each year.

In 2009, 78 percent of Oregon's population resided in one of Oregon's six metropolitan statistical areas (MSA) - a gain of over one percentage point since 2000. Despite this overall increase in the metropolitan share of Oregon's population, for the past three years, all six of the MSAs experienced continual yearly declines in the rate at which their population is growing. Still, most of Oregon's newcomers are either moving into, or close to, urbanized areas with large population centers (50,000 or more persons). The amount of increase in each MSA during the nine year period varied between around 8,600 (Corvallis MSA) and over one-quarter million persons (Portland-Vancouver-Beaverton MSA). The Bend MSA, the only MSA located away from Oregon's I-5 corridor (which stretches north and south across the western portion of the state), has added the largest number of persons since 2000 after the Portland-Vancouver-Beaverton MSA. From 2000 to 2009, it has grown by 48 percent. All of the other MSAs increased by between seven and fifteen percent during the same time period.

Population change varies across Oregon's 36 counties. Several counties experienced 2000-2009 population growth at rates higher than the state (12 percent), and a few saw slight decreases in the number of their residents. Seven counties undergoing the greatest change each added around 25,000 or more persons from 2000-2009. All of these counties except for Deschutes, are located in the Portland metropolitan area or along the state's I-5 corridor.

Although Multnomah County captures the largest county share of the State's population (19 percent in 2009), Washington County added the largest number of persons during 2000-2009. Since 2000, almost 82,000 persons have been added to Washington County's population. During the same period, Multnomah County increased by around 64,200 persons, and Deschutes County, which ranks third in the number of persons added, increased its population by about 55,300. Two other counties in Oregon experienced an increase of at least 30,000. Clackamas County increased by 41,500 persons, and Marion County added 33,300. Jackson and Lane Counties follow not too far behind with each adding 25,700 and 24,700 persons, respectively. Sixteen other Oregon counties added roughly between 1,000-10,000 persons during the 9-year period.

Five of Oregon's counties, Grant, Baker, Wallowa, Sherman, and Gilliam, experienced a small loss of population from 2000 to 2009. Each of these counties had fewer births than deaths occurring during the time period, but only two of them had fewer persons moving in than moving out (Grant and Sherman).

The combined population of Oregon's 242 incorporated cities and towns is estimated to have reached 2,671,032 on July 1, 2009, accounting for 70 percent of Oregon's total population. Experiencing a collective increase of 3 percentage points since 2000, there has been a continuous slight upward trend for Oregon's population to reside in incorporated cities and towns rather than in unincorporated or rural areas. However, in 2009 only one city in Oregon had an estimated population of over 200,000 – Portland with 582,130 persons – and nine with between 50,000 and 200,000 residents. Eighty percent of cities in Oregon have an estimated 2009 population of under 10,000; and of these cities, 81 each have fewer than 1,000 residents.

### **Population Estimates for Oregon, July 1, 2009**

This report contains the annual population estimates for Oregon, and its counties, incorporated cities, and unincorporated areas for July 1, 2009. Included in ten tables are the estimates summarized by unincorporated and incorporated areas at the state level, as well as metropolitan areas and non-metropolitan areas. Some tables include historical estimates and Census populations. Other tables display the components of population change (natural increase and net migration), and some show population estimates for age groups and gender by county. The population estimates for cities are presented in three tables; one is alphabetized, another shows population in rank order, and the other holds city estimates grouped by the county in which the city is located. For cities that are located in more than one county, population estimates for city parts are shown together in a separate table. Also, populations added to cities due to annexations from April 1, 2000 to July 1, 2009 are included in a table.

At the end of this report there is a county reference map that shows the locations of cities throughout Oregon, along with two graphs. One graph depicts the annual growth rates experienced by Oregon over the past 30 years. The other graph shows Oregon's trends of natural increase and net migration during the same time period.

Please note that when determining change in city population over time, the annexation table in this report should be consulted to help explain possible reasons for the magnitude of change. In addition, please check the Population Research Center's quarterly Population Supplement Report, available online, to find revised populations due to annexations or enumerations that were conducted since the certification of the July 1, 2009

population estimates. July 1 population estimates are certified in December 15, 2009.

### **State Requirements for Population Estimates and the History of the Population Research Center**

Oregon law (Oregon Revised Statutes 190.510 to 190.610) mandates the Population Research Center, Portland State University, acting on behalf of the State Board of Higher Education, to prepare annual population estimates for each county and incorporated city in the state of Oregon. The principal purpose of the population estimates is for the allocation of selected State funds to Oregon's cities and counties.

The State government organized a State Census Office in Portland in 1956. The purpose of the State Census Office was to oversee and certify special censuses that rapidly growing towns conducted in order to document their population figures. The State Census Office eventually expanded its role to include the certification of the population added by annexations and the preparation of annual population estimates for counties and cities.

Administrative responsibilities for the population estimates were transferred to Portland State University's Center for Population Research and Census in 1965, when Portland State College became a university. The Center for Population Research and Census, now known as the Population Research Center (PRC), is located within the College of Urban and Public Affairs.

### **Duties of the Population Center**

In addition to preparing the annual population estimates, PRC houses Oregon's Census State Data Center, the lead agency in Oregon for contact and collaboration with the U.S. Census Bureau and for dissemination of census data and documents. This information includes current and past census data for Oregon as well as results from Census Bureau surveys.

PRC also serves as Oregon's representing agency in the Federal-State Cooperative for Population Estimates (FSCPE). Through the FSCPE, PRC and Census Bureau staff work in partnership for the improvement of demographic methods to develop sub-national population estimates.

PRC conducts research with a focus on the investigation of the causes and consequences of demographic change in today's society. Typical research areas include social and economic factors affecting demographic change, population distribution and migration, population geography, survey investigation on population issues, enrollment forecasts for school districts, community assessment for special needs programs, and demographic methods. PRC staff regularly assist and provide demographic data and

analysis to city, county, and state and local government agencies and other community partners. The primary geographic areas of study for PRC staff are in the states of Oregon and Washington.

### Methods for Developing the Population Estimates

All residents of Oregon's cities, counties, and unincorporated areas are included in the population estimates tables in this report. Residents include people living in housing units (single-family and multi-family units; mobile homes; special housing units, such as boats, tents, motel rooms), and in group quarter facilities (such as college dormitories, nursing homes, jails and prisons). We count residents as persons living at the place that they consider to be their usual residence, or where they are residing at least 6 months of the year.

We have developed methods for Oregon's population estimates to be as accurate as possible. Toward this goal, we work closely with state, county, and city officials. We request annual information from them and invite their review of our methods and estimates.

To estimate the State population, we use the following equation that defines population in 2009 as the population in 2000 plus the sum of two basic components, natural increase and net migration, during 2000 to 2009\*.

$$\text{Pop.}_{(09)} = \text{Pop.}_{(00)} + \text{Nat. Incr.}_{(00-09)} + \text{Net Mig.}_{(00-09)}$$

We rely on the registration of births and deaths to estimate Oregon's natural increase (the number of births minus deaths). To estimate the net migration (in-migrants minus out-migrants), we use data on school enrollment, employment, labor force, state income tax exemptions, driver license issuances, voter registration, and Medicare enrollees. We utilize a method, called ratio correlation that relates the changes in these data since the last census to changes in population and net migration during the same time period.

We use a composite of two methods to estimate county population: 1) a ratio correlation method, and 2) a modified component method. In the ratio correlation method, we track changes in state income tax exemptions, school enrollment, the number of births, driver license issuances, and Medicare enrollment data to produce an estimate of the current county populations. In the component method, we determine the natural increase for each county, and estimate net migration based on recent historical trends. In addition, we examine changes in the housing stock to verify the accuracy of the county estimates and make adjustments, if necessary.

We develop population estimates for Oregon's cities according to the changes in their housing stock and group quarters population. City officials report to PRC each year the changes in their city's housing stock (for single-

family units, multi-family units, and mobile homes) and the number of persons residing in group quarters facilities. For each city, we assume an average number of persons per housing unit (PPHU) by housing type calculated from the most recent census data collected. Applying the PPHU to the current housing stock and adding group quarters population, we arrive the city-level population estimate. We take into account any population changes due to annexations produce the city's final population estimate. Please note that if a city has not submitted recent data, we hold its population constant to its previously certified estimate.

The number of persons residing in the county unincorporated areas is estimated by calculating the residual of the total county population and the sum of the cities' populations in the same county. Some adjustments may be made according to recent data on housing growth and changes in group quarter population that county officials provide us. Use caution when comparing the population estimates of the unincorporated county areas over time, and note that they represent revised estimates rather than estimates resulting from direct change during the year.

We monitor city annexations throughout the year. We are notified about annexations by the office of the Secretary of State. When an annexation occurs, we contact city officials to request the number of residential housing units and population, if any, that were involved in the annexation. If the annexation added to the city's population, we certify an updated city population, which is done on a quarterly basis. We inform the Secretary of State's office of any revised populations by special notification, and each quarter we publish online the revised populations in a supplement to our annual population estimates report.

In mid-November each year, we make available to the public the preliminary annual July 1 population estimates for Oregon and its cities and counties. There is a one-month review period during which we receive feedback from state, city and county officials and other community partners. During this time we may make additional adjustments to the estimates prior to certification. We certify the final July 1 population estimates December 15th. We publish the state, city and county estimates on our website ([www.pdx.edu/prc](http://www.pdx.edu/prc)) shortly after. This annual population report, which includes the complete set of population estimates, is usually available online by March the following year.

\*Natural increase and net migration are estimated for the fiscal year, beginning July 1 in one year and ending June 30 in the following year.

# Reference Map: Oregon Counties and Location of Cities

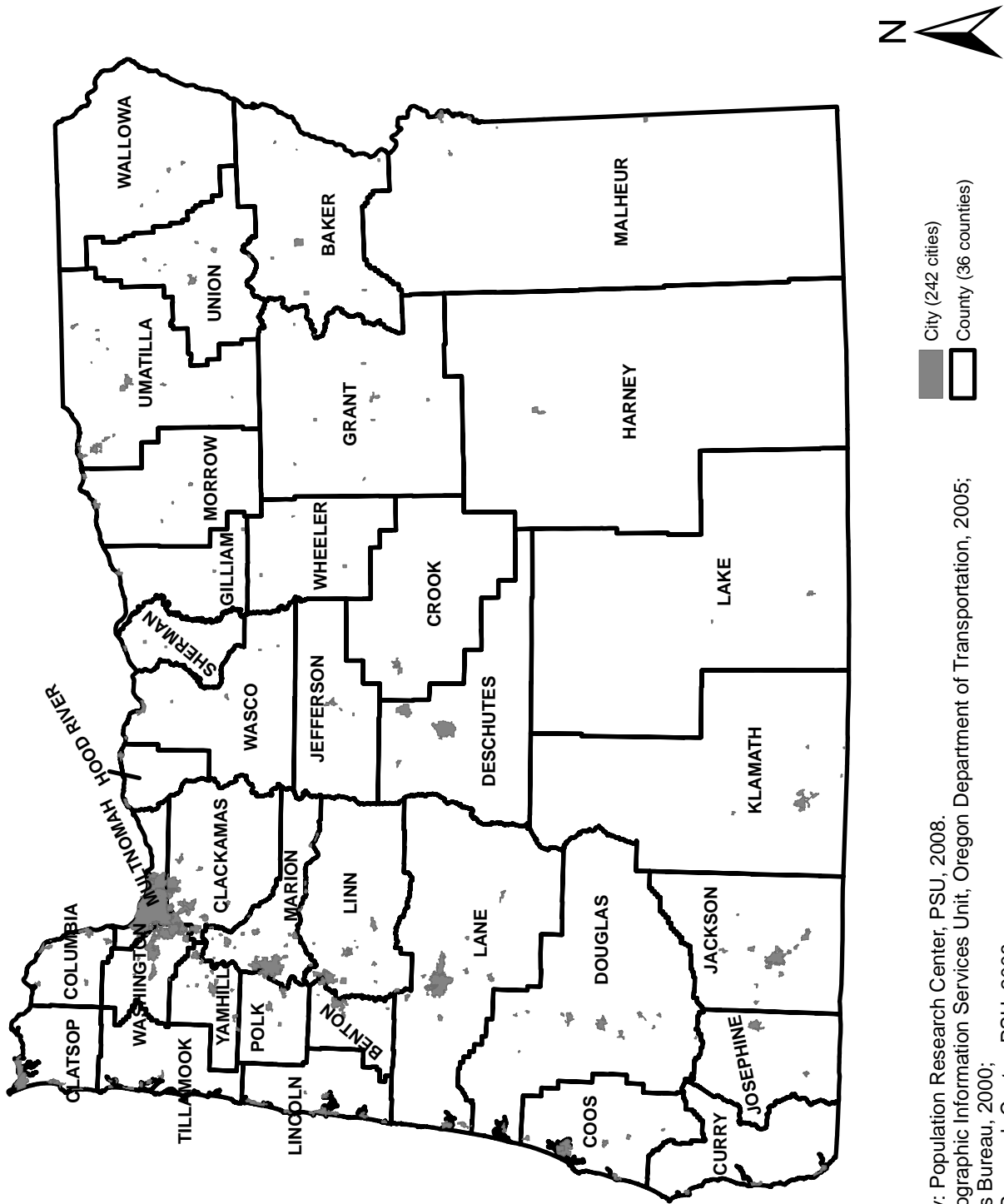

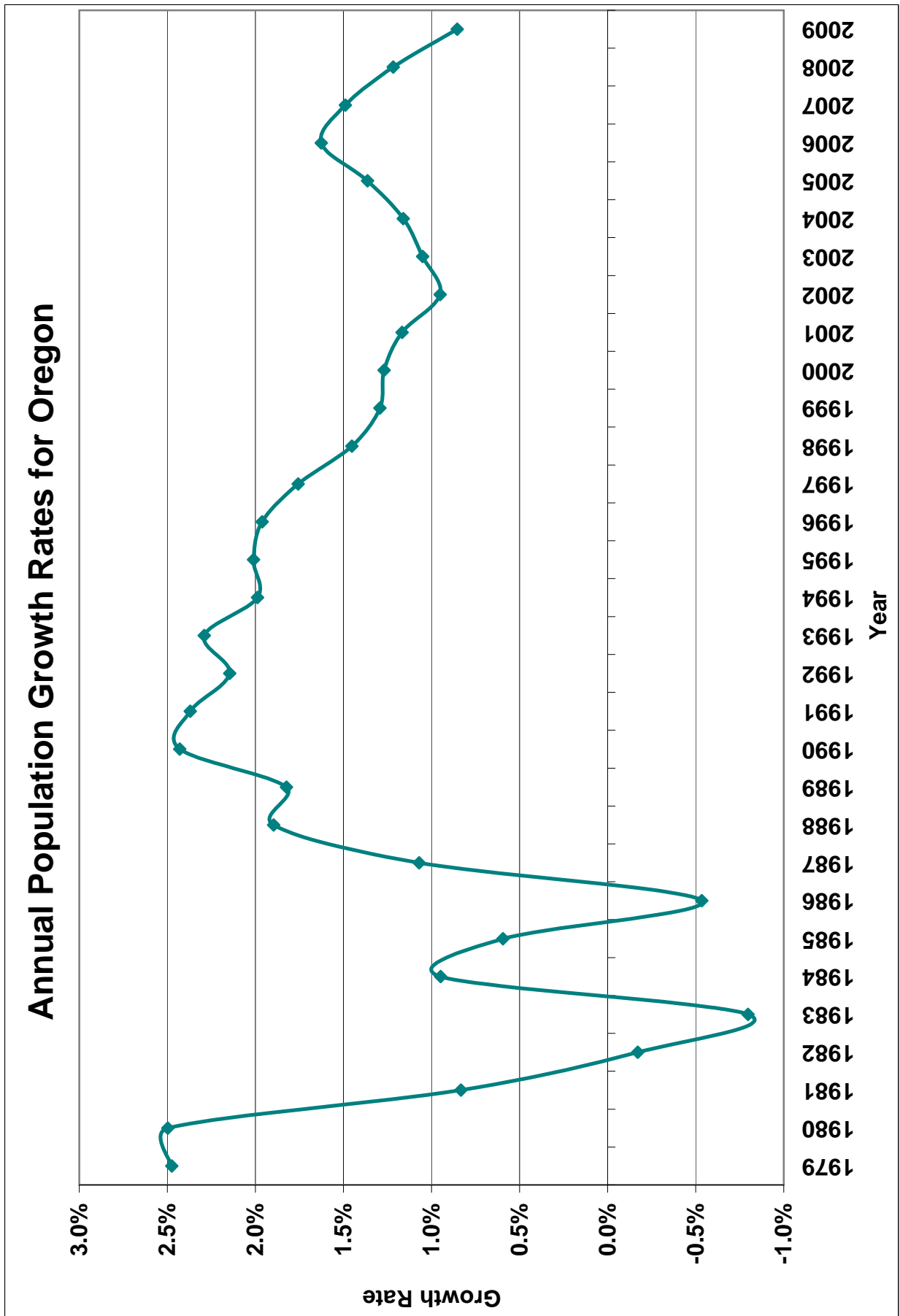
