Articulation/Transfer Agreement PSU Contract # 506066

THIS ARTICULATION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is entered into and by and between Portland State University ("PSU") and American Samoa Community College ("ASCC"), each a "Party" and together the "Parties".

Background

Whereas, PSU is a comprehensive research university that serves its students and the people of Oregon, the nation, and the world through the creation and transfer of knowledge in the liberal arts, the natural and social sciences, and the professions; and

Whereas, ASCC was established in 1970 to provide post-secondary education opportunities in Liberal Arts, Teacher Training, Vocational-Technical Education and General Educations to the residents of American Samoa; and

Whereas, ASCC and PSU are accredited by the Accrediting Commission of Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) respectively, as institutional accrediting bodies recognized by US Department of Education.

It is in the interest of both ASCC and PSU to facilitate the transfer of qualified students from ASCC to PSU.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties, for good and sufficient consideration, agree as follows:

PSU agrees to accept credits for students transferring from ASCC to PSU, as outlined in Exhibit A, Articulation and Transfer Criteria, and Table A, Credit Transfer Guide, which are hereby incorporated and made a part of this Agreement. In the event of a discrepancy between Exhibit A and this Agreement, the language of the Agreement shall take precedence.

Terms and Conditions

This Agreement shall commence Fall, 2019 or on the date of the last signature below, whichever is later, and shall terminate on June 30, 2026 unless terminated earlier as provided herein. This Agreement shall be effective for students who apply to transfer from ASCC to PSU beginning with PSU's Fall term. This Agreement may be

- 5. Force Majeure. - 6. Execution and Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original, all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
- 7. MERGER. THIS AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES. NO WAIVER, CONSENT, MODIFICATION, OR CHANGE OF TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BIND EITHER PARTY UNLESS IN WRITING AND SIGNED BY BOTH PARTIES. SUCH WAIVER, CONSENT, MODIFICATION, OR CHANGE, IF MADE, SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ONLY IN THE SPECIFIC INSTANCE AND FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE GIVEN. THERE ARE NO UNDERSTANDINGS, AGREEMENTS, OR REPRESENTATIONS, ORAL OR WRITTEN, NOT SPECIFIED HEREIN REGARDING THIS AGREEMENT.
