TIPS FOR PARKING:

Any PSU permit or meter receipt is valid for that date and time in any disabled space in conjunction with a valid disabled placard.

TIPS FOR TRANSIT:

All buses and rail cars are equipped with wheelchair lifts or ramps. On the streetcar or MAX, press the ramp button to deploy the ramp.

PARKING AT CLSB:

When parking in disabled spaces at CLSB, you must pay the posted hourly/daily rate. Please contact our office for additional information.

CHOOSING THE RIGHT OPTION FOR YOU

Transportation & Parking Services strives to make commuting as accessible and worry-free as possible. This sheet outlines some of the basic services our office offers. Please don't hesitate to contact us with any question you may have.



Commuting by Car or Van

We can help you find accessible parking spaces, assist you with using multi-space parking meters, and help you find the permit that's right for your schedule.

All PSU parking facilities provide accessible parking stalls for individuals with valid disabled placards. We offer hourly parking for the occasional trip and permit parking for the academic term or year.

Helpful Tips

- » Disabled placard holders may purchase any yearly or term permit at the listed rate, including those listed as sold out.
- » A PSU permit or meter receipt is valid in any marked disabled space on campus when using a valid disabled placard.
- » Day and time restrictions still apply to time-limited PSU permits.
- » A disabled placard does not allow free parking within PSU facilities.

It's inexpensive and hassle-free! Our in-house transit experts can help plan your trip using the Portland Streetcar, TriMet bus or MAX light rail — or all three! Each of these modes are accessible and available right in the heart of campus.
