Article IV, Section F. Department Chair, ADD:

5. Evaluation of Chair

At the end of the first and second year of a Chair's term, an anonymous electronic survey will be sent to all NTTF and tenure-track faculty members so that they can provide input to the Chair. Response to the survey is optional and will not be tracked. The survey questions will cover the same areas as are evaluated in the Chair's Annual Review.

The Associate Chair has the same approval and voting rights as elected members of the Advisory Council.
